About Selenium

Selenium is an application designed to assist with conducting research on the Internet. It allows you to create multiple projects, each of which has its own writing section, bibliography manager, outline editor and PDF manager. Selenium also incorporates a full-featured tabbed web browser to allow you to conduct research and work with the information you find all from within the same application.

What's New

New Features

- Added option to view word processor as a continuous text area
- Added ability to override SSL certificate errors
- Bibliography entries and bookmarks can be copied and pasted

Changes

- The bookmarks and history are now located in a sheet

Bug Fixes

- Fixed crash on launch after closing with an unloaded tab
- Newly added bookmarks only appear in the bookmarks bar if added to the bookmarks bar collection
- Search fields in embedded toolbars can now receive focus
- Citation Styles window toolbar now saves its state
- Reduced graphical glitches in main split view
- Changes made while editing bibliography entries are saved when navigating using the arrow buttons
- Default image snippet picture is hidden when an image snippet is selected

Installing Selenium

To install Selenium, just drag it to your Applications folder or anywhere else you wish to keep it.

Getting Started

Due to changes in the way Selenium stores information, you will need to manually enter any data from Googalyzer 3.0 beta 2 or earlier. If this is the first time you have ever used Selenium, it will create a new project for you to work with. Double click the project

in the light blue source list to rename it. Selenium's modes can be toggled using the tabs in the toolbar, or by choosing the mode you want from the View > Editing Mode menu. To use Selenium's browser features, simply enter a URL in text field beneath the toolbar or a search term in the Google Search field.

Getting Help

Selenium is designed to be easy to use, but if you need help, you're not out of luck. The built in help, accessible by choosing Help > Selenium Help, should solve most basic problems.
