Clicking this will quit the actual program.

1.8 Main Window - Drag Bar

3.1 MAIN WINDOW - Drag Bar

Yeah I know, it's pretty stupid of me explaining this, but it makes this more complete, okay?

Like most windows, you can click on the titlebar with the left mouse button and move the window, and then release the mouse button. This puts it in a new position. Sorry all you non-beginner users out there!

1.9 Main Window - Depth Gadget

3.1 MAIN WINDOW - Depth Gadget

As with all programs with this symbol, this will put the window to the back/front, depending on it's current position.

1.10 Main Window - Article/File List

Use ADD to add more articles to the Article List for processing or use Remove to remove any from the list. Clear will clear-out the whole list. Files can also be added by dragging icons into the window. Don't drag any dirs! See Future

1.11 Main Window - ADD

3.1 MAIN WINDOW - Add

Clicking on this will bring-up the loadfile(s) requester, use this to select files. To select more than 1 file, hold down the Shift key and click on the files in the list.

To select all the files, click on the ALL gadget. You can optionally use the Pattern string to hide/show certain files.

Upto 500 articles can be can be entered. If you have more than 500 articles to process (yeh, right!), then do the first 500, Clear the list, and then select the others.

Also, articles can have no more than 3,000 lines. The reason for these limitations is to save some memory.

Files can also be added by dragging icons into the window. Don't drag any dirs! See

1.12 Main Window - REMOVE

3.1 MAIN WINDOW - Remove

If this is enabled (it'll appear de-pressed), any files you click on in the Article list

, will be removed.

1.13 Main Window - CLEAR

3.1 MAIN WINDOW - Clear When Clear is selected, you'll be asked if you are sure you want to clear the Article list (this is to avoid accidentally clearing the list). Once you've cleared the list, you can't get it back unless you re-select the files via the Add gadget.

1.14 Main Window - Action

3.1 MAIN WINDOW - Action This cycle gadget is used to specify what type of action you would like to take upon the file(s) in the Article list . The following modes are available: Insert Colour Codes This will insert colour codes into your article(s). To tell TWCI where to insert a colour code, you have to put @C at the start of a line. In TWCI v2.5, 64 colours are currently implemented. Remove Colour Codes This will remove all the colour codes from the articles in the Article filelist. Remove Font Codes This will remove all the font codes found in the articles in the Article

filelist.

1.15 Main Window - Fondle Away!

3.1 MAIN WINDOW - Fondle Away!
This will start the actual processing of the files in the
 Article
 filelist. The type of processing depends on the state of the
 Action
 cycle gadget.
You'll get a nifty window displaying 2 progress bars. The first
progress bar tells you how far through the
 Article filelist
 TWCI is,

and the second progress bar tells you how far through the current article TWCI is.

The second progress bar has two functions. The first function tells you how much of the article has been processed, then the bar is cleared. Then it tells you how much of the current article has been saved (to give you a visual indication of how long it'll take to save the current article back to disk/ram/whatever).

WARNING: You may be wondering where the articles get saved to once they have been processed. Well, the original articles get overwritten by the processed articles. So copy the articles to a new place if you don't want the originals overwritten.

- 26/8/97, V2.50 Again totally re-coded from scratch. The GUI has also been re-designed to enable batch processing of upto 500 articles. Will be released in The Word #17.
- 22/9/97, V2.50 Used a new routine for detecting the current screen's font height. Now the ENV:Sys/fonts.prefs file doesn't need to be examined and 1k is saved on the main executable.
