This is a "feature" of MacOS 8. Apparently, those at Apple never anticipated the use of alternate window styles in clipping files. As a result, the areas that would normaly contain the scroll bars and grow box are not erased prior to opening the window. The

is the information that area of memory ocupied prior to the window using it.
