

Driver Definitions

Note: A Drive is specialized software designed to act as an interface between a program and a particular device

[Text] = Field only exists under given circumstance

- **Driver#** = Reference number of the driver
 - ◇ **Name** = Driver name, always preceded by a period
 - ◇ **Version** = Version of driver
 - ◇ **PPC Native** = Is driver code written for PowerPC
 - + **Category** = Category code
 - + **Service** = Type of service code
 - + **Description** = Name Registry description
 - ◇ **Type** = What it provides support for
 - ◇ **Interface** = Interface type of driver
 - ◇ **SCSI#** = Number of SCSI device [SCSI Driver]
 - ◇ **Slot#** = Slot Number of card which it may support
 - ◇ **Unit#** = Position which the device occupies in the unit table
 - ◇ **Status** = Open/Closed
 - ◇ **Location** = ROM/RAM
 - ◇ **Address** = Hex address of driver
 - ◇ **Original Flags Enabled** = Flags which were active when the driver was loaded. These flags provide information about how the operating system should interact with the driver
 - ◇ **Current Flags Enabled** = Flags which are currently active
