Wacom Tablet Driver Release Notes

This application is a *Beta version (April 25, 2001)* of the Wacom Co. driver for MacOS X. It is provided free of charge to end-users to be used **exclusively** with the Toon Boom Studio v1.0 software.

Tablet Models Supported

This Beta Wacom tablet driver for OS X will support the following Wacom tablets:

- USB versions of the Intuos product line (model numbers GD-0405-U, GD-0608-U, GD-0912-U, GD-1212-U and GD-1218-U)
- USB version of the Graphire tablets (model number ET-0405-U)
- USB versions of the PenPartner tablets (model number CT-0405-U)
- USB versions of the PL product line (model numbers PL-500-U and PL-400 with PLB-02 Converter Box).

Recommendations for tablet users

- 1. After the release of both the Wacom OS X beta driver and appropriate support within OS X all customers should be able to upgrade to OS X. At that time, tablet support in Native Space and Classic Space should be available to assure full functionality of the supported Wacom tablets.
- 2. As a general caution, users should not be surprised if they encounter some unforeseen problems running early versions of a new operating system. To reduce potentially significant complications with legacy interfaces and connections, Wacom recommends to upgrade only newer computers to Mac OS X and to continue using the current Mac OS on computers that are older than approximately two years. Users that upgrade to OS X should further replace their serial or ADB hardware with USB versions. 3. This Beta Wacom tablet driven operates best under Mac OS 10.0.4.

Installation

The "Tablet Driver Final" file must be moved in the "Application" directory. Once a USB Wacom device has been connected to a Mac OS X computer, this application must first be launched prior to any other application to activate the tablet. While running, this application allows you to control the main cursor jointly with your standard pointing device (mouse).

To "quit" the Tablet Driver application, you must use "Force Quit" that is located under the Apple menu.

LIMITATION

This Beta driver offers limited capability compared to the standard market leading WACOM products. It does support pressure sensitivity but offers limited sensitivity to detect "click/ unclick". WACOM has conducted limited testing of this application to ensure security and minimum performance. However this software is provided with no warranty and no support of any sorts. The user is installing and using this software at

his/her own risk. This software is the property of Wacom Co. It is loaned to you for your convenience and should be removed from your computer as soon as the commercial version of the same product becomes available. This Beta driver is known to hang the OS under certain conditions.
