what is it?

I first started writing this program a few months ago, mainly because I was extremely jealous of the Microsoft Office bar which is found on most PCees. MagicBar is a small desktop commodity that hooks itself onto your Workbench, Scalos or DOpus screen and can be used to launch CLI programs by clicking on your own custom gadgets.

MagicBar offers:

- + Custom background textures
 - + Custom gadget support
 - + Custom layout
 - + Left or Right aligned bar
 - + Background or OnTop options
 - + FastIPrefs `Full Workbench` compatible
 - + AutoHide facility
 - + Custom title bar name
 - + Custom `tools` menu
 - + Font sensitive
 - + The colours and styles of MagicWB
 - + Super low CPU eater!
 - + It's a commodity! and so can be removed via exchange! :)

1.8 Usage

usage

To run MagicBar - double click on it's icon or add it to your startup-sequence AFTER the loadwb command.

When MagicBar loads it will look for a file called `MagicBar.CFG` in the directory that MagicBar was executed from. In order to customize MagicBar to your liking - you will need to use a text editor such as ED to edit this config file.

The MagicBar.CFG file contains two different types of information. These are: 1. The MagicBar configuration and 2. The Gadget and Program launch information.

1. Configuration

All options in the config file start with a hash (#). The following options are available to you in order to personalize your MagicBar:-

`#View=[0/1/2/3/4]`

The command `View` enables you to set shadows etc on the Bar.

`#AutoHide=[True/False]`

Auto hide will cause the MagicBar to disappear if your mouse pointer is away from the bar. In order to bring to bar back, simply shift your mouse to the left or right most side of the screen.

`#Align=[Left/Right]`

Sets the position of the MagicBar.

`#Delay=[(Time)]`

Gives a delay before the MagicBar window appears.

`#Back=[(ILBM)]`

Changes the background texture of the bar.

`#OnTop=[True/False]`

Sets the position of the bar (Ontop or behind all windows)

`#Title=[Title]`

Sets the screen title of MagicBar

`#Sound=[IFF Sound File]`

Causes MagicBar to play the specified sound file when a gadget is pressed. [Requires the command `Play16` in your C: directory]

`#Welcome=[True/False]`

Enables/Disables the MagicBar start-up progress bar.

2. Gadget options

To add a gadget and launch details to the MagicBar, begin with the AT symbol (@), followed by a command and it's arguments and then a comma followed by the location of the gadget ILBM.

Example: @Sys:Tools/Calculator,E9:MagicBar/GADGETS/Calc.IFF
