Welcome to CardMate! This is just a simple application to extract useful information from a cardfile (.CRD format). The information you extract will be saved in a plain-text ASCII format and can be edited with a wordprocessor. You can extract the whole card, telephone numbers, email addresses, mailing addresses, or dates.

After the extraction, a wordprocessor of your choice will appear. You can then edit and print the extracted document.

Getting Started

Follow these steps to extract:

1. Select a wordprocessor from the Options Menu:

Options

.....Select Wordprocessor

For the first time, a good wordprocessor to choose is C:\WINDOWS\
NOTEPAD.EXE. In subsequent sessions, CardMate will remember the chosen wordprocessor.

2. Open a cardfile to analyze by selecting the following from the menu:

File

.....Open Cardfile for Input

- 3. Select Extract from the menu
- All retrieves info from the whole card
- Telephone extracts telephone numbers
- Email retrieves email addresses
- Mailing Address retrieves mailing addresses
- Dates extracts dates

Click on extraction algorithms to see the selection criteria.

- 4. Enter the name of the output file where the extraction will be saved
- 5. If there is a check next to the Display Wordprocessor item in the optionsthen a wordprocessor will appear with the generated text. From the wordprocessor, you can reformat and then print the text.

Options

Page Titles indicates whether the date header will appear at the top of the page.

Page Width sets the number of characters that can be printed across. This is only useful for extracting telephone numbers where the width can become fairly large. See Tips and Tricks more information.

Display Wordprocessor indicates whether or not a wordprocessor will appear after the extraction.

Wordprocessor allows you to change the name of the wordprocessor that appears after the extraction process. You can change it to NOTEPAD.EXE, WRITE.EXE, WINWORD.EXE, WPWIN.EXE etc...

Note that you will probably have to select the range of text and change the front to COURIER so that the spacing will not be messed up. See Tips and Tricks for more information.

Tips and Tricks

If you have a lot of telephone numbers, you might want to change the size of the fonts. Do this when your wordprocessor appears by selecting the whole text and choosing the COURIER font with a size of 8 or less. You can even put smaller sizes into newspaper columns.

For addresses, try setting up some newspaper columns in your wordprocessor. This will allow for the whole page to be used.

If you repeat these functions often, you might consider creating a macro in your wordprocessor.

Important Notice

This program is copyrighted and may not be altered in any way. Feel free to redistribute this program as long as no fee whatsoever is charged.

Note that the extraction algorithms are not perfect, so always double check the results. In any case, the program is distributed "as is" and I will not be responsible for any consequences arising from the use of CARDMATE.

Selecting TextOn most wordprocessors, the range of text can be selected by typing CTRL-A or by holding down the mouse button and dragging the mouse down the page.

Extraction Algorithms

All retrieves info from the whole card

Telephone retrieves lines containing 7 or more numbers interrupted only by the following characters: () - .

Email retrieves only lines containing the @ symbol

Mailing Address retrieves all the lines which are not recognized as either telephone numbers or email addresses.

Date retrieves the lines that contain a month or a three letter abbreviation of the month followed by a spaces, period, or hyphen.

Shortcomings...

This progam has two major shortcomings. First, the extraction routines are limited and data may be incorrectly retrieved. Second, information on cards that contain graphic images will be ignored. This is because I have not yet figured out how graphic images are stored in the cardfile. If you have any knowledge on .CRD file formats, please Email me so I can fix this shortcoming...
