The Sparta File Management Shell For Windows 3.1

Brief Instruction Manual

Sparta Personal Edition ALPHA Release 1.0. March 1993. FREEWARE

Launching

Close the Windows 3.1 File Manager if it's open.

Either setup Sparta in the Program Manager or run it from Program Manager's File-Run option. SPARTA.EXE <path to the desktop directory(Must exist)>

Example: SPARTA.EXE C:\DESKTOP

Key Operations

Qwerty Keys Quick Key selection of files. (Type the first letters of

a file quickly and it will be selected a la Norton's NCD).

ENTER Launches a file or opens a folder.

Selection And Drag Operations

Left Mouse Click Selects a file.

Shift+Left Mouse Click Selects a file without deselecting previously selected files.

Drag then Drop Moves dragged files.
Drag then Ctrl+Drop Copies dragged files.

Selected File Operations

Ctrl+R Renames the selected file.

Ctrl+l Displays information on the selected file.

Folder Operations

Ctrl+L Displays a menu of open folders.

Ctrl+Alt+Left Mouse Click Creates a directory in the clicked folder.

Alt+Right Mouse Click Folder's status information.

Left Mouse Double Click Launches a file or opens a folder.

Alt+Left Mouse Double Click Allows detailed launch information.

Ctrl+W Closes the selected folder.

Dustbin Operations

Right Mouse Double Click Open the dustbin directory.

Features Not Yet Accessible In ALPHA 1.0

File Find (implemented 02-93)

Associate executable with extension (implemented 02-93)

Change Font (implemented 02-93) Format Disk (implemented 03-93)

Filter Files In Directory View (implemented 02-93)

Save Detailed Launch Information (Not yet implemented)

Cursor Control In Directory Views (Not yet implemented)

Quick Menu Launching(similar to Backmenu) (Not yet implemented)

Small icon views (Network Edition only. Not yet implemented)
Network Support (Network Edition only. Implemented but unstable)

Known Bugs In ALPHA 1.0

- The Move/Copy Cancel button is unresponsive and erratic.
- Create directory always reports an error if you try to a create directory called "New dir".
- If you have too many devices or a small screen the desktop disks become cluttered.
- Updating of icon captions is a bit shaky.
- Files cannot be replaced when copy or move is performed

You can add your own extension by editing the [Extensions] section of WIN.INI.

Example:

[Extensions] cal=calendar.exe ^.cal
