Preferences

The Preferences dialogue box allows you to customize screen settings for Java Script It!. These settings will be saved to the initialization file ("js.ini") and reloaded each time Java Script It! is launched.

A checkmark in the checkboxes located in the **Window Settings** section indicates that the setting will take place upon lauch.

You can change the default font that Java Script It! applies to the text area (code) of each application through the **Font Settings** section. Note that the Font Settings will take place right away.

The **Browser** section allows you to link Java Script It! to the web browser of your choice. Just choose the **Browse** button and locate the browser's executable (ex: "c:\communicator\program\netscape.exe"). If you leave or set the **Browser** section to "default" then the system web browser will be loaded (ex: M.I.E). The web browser specified will be used when you click on the **Test** menu item within the various applications of this program.

The Preferences dialogue box can be accessed under the **View** menu of the main Java Script It! interface.
