

Steps for Working Buttons

1. Load

Click on the **Load** button to open the HTML file that you wish to add the Working Buttons to.

2. Insertion Point

Place your cursor in document between the body tags (<body>...</body>) where you want to insert the Working Button. You do not need to select (highlight) anything.

3. Apply

Click the **Apply** button to bring up the settings dialogue box.

4. Setup

Type in the **Button Caption** that you want to appear on the button. Choose whether you want to **Target** the current frame (Self) or the frameset (Parent). Unless your document is contained in a frame and you want the URL of the button to break the frame and load the whole window, choose Self. Type in the **URL** that you want the button to load into the browser upon clicking.

5. Saving Changes

If you want to test the code or just save the file, click on the **Update** button. This button acts like a Save button in most Windows applications. If you decide you want to save the changes under a new name or in a new location, then click on the **Save As** button. If you are unhappy with the results after testing, choose **Revert** from under the **Edit** menu. If you are done with Working Buttons then click on the **Close** button (this will not close Java Script It!). If you want to apply Working Buttons to another document, just repeat steps 1 to 5.
