With this option, you can "layer-in" up to 99,999,999 different layers or groupings of records in the Master File. Once you identify a new group of records, you can separate them by assigning a unique CATEGORY number to the group while you are entering their information into the Master File. From that point on, anytime you wish to segregate that block of records from either the Master File or Activity file, just go to the Main Program Menu and enter the Select Category option.
