Chapter 1

Tag-o-Miga

1.1 Tag-o-Miga

This AmigaGuide describes how Tag-o-Miga's GUI is used. The GUI will appear after editing a message, provided the following conditions are met:

1. You actually changed the message (i.e. you did not quit your text editor without saving)
2. The GUI is switched on using Tag-o-Miga-Prefs

The GUI contains two windows, as described below.

Main window

Choose taglines

1.2 Tag-o-Miga

The main window is the first window to appear. It contains a preview of the message, a number of options to change the message, and OK and Cancel buttons.

Message preview

Change message options

1.3 Message preview

The listview contains a preview of the message as it will look after Tag-o-Miga has added taglines, etc. to it. If you do not like the way it looks, you can change the message using the other buttons in the window.

1.4 Change message options

The six buttons below the message preview allow you to change various aspects of the message.

Edit message...

Change mood...

Change header...

Change NP...

Change signature...

Change tagline...

1.5 Edit message...

Clicking this button will start your text editor again, for you to change the message body.

1.6 Change mood...

Clicking on this button will allow you to change or remove the

1.7 Change header...

Clicking on this button will allow you to change or remove the header that Tag-o-Miga has chosen for your message.

1.8 Change NP...

Clicking on this button will allow you to change or remove the Now Playing line that Tag-o-Miga has chosen for your message.

1.9 Change signature...

Clicking on this button will allow you to change or remove the signature that Tag-o-Miga has chosen for your message.

1.10 Change tagline...

Clicking on this button will allow you to change or remove the tagline that Tag-o-Miga has chosen for your message.

1.11 OK

Clicking on this button will make all the changes to your message as shown in the preview and return the message to your mail reader.

1.12 Cancel

Clicking on this button will cause Tag-o-Miga to return your message, unchanged, to your mail reader (i.e. no taglines, etc. will be added).

1.13 Choose taglines - Tag-o-Miga

This window is where you can change part of your message.

1.14 Tagfile name

This string gadget contains the name of the current tagfile.

To load a new tagfile, you can use the "popfile" button next to the string gadget to pop up a file requester.

1.15 List of taglines

Most of the window is taken up with a list of taglines in the current file. You can select a tagline simply by clicking on it -- as you do so, the tagline preview should update itself.

1.16 Tagline preview

This lower listview contains a preview of the selected tagline, in full and with macro changes made.

1.17 Back

If you have "nested" tagfiles using the special [ALTLIST] key in tagfiles (see Tag-o-Miga.guide), clicking this button will move a step back and show you the tagfile containing the [ALTLIST] reference to the current tagfile.

1.18 Random

Clicking on this button will cause Tag-o-Miga to select a tagline at random for the current file.

1.19 OK

Clicking on this button will tell Tag-o-Miga to use the tagline you have selected.

If the tagline selected is an [ALTLIST] line, then the new tagfile will be loaded and displayed.

If the tagline selected is a [COMMENT] line, then this button will have no effect.

1.20 Cancel

Clicking on this button will tell Tag-o-Miga that you don't want to change the tagline after all.
