Everybody LOVES dingbats, right? There are a lot of pretty neat sets out there, and this one is my favourite (for the time being at least). Some of these dingbats are VERY VERY detailed, and really surprising. This Dingbat set is hype! I can't put it into words.. Just install it in ATM, if you hate it- fine, kill it. I don't think you will dislike it. The only problem I've encountered is installing it into CorelDraw- WfnBoss chokes on most of the more complex dingbats- and thats about 75% of them.

So, in CorelDraw you lose most of them- But in ATM it 'll work great.

DavysOtherDingbats is a Type 1 pictorial PostScript font. It will work with Adobe Type Manager, version 1.2 or higher. To install the font, install like any other PostScript font. Both the regular and shift keyboard are filled with pictorial characters. There are no characters on either of the option keyboards. Because the outline font is so large (around 107K), it is advised you use it sparingly with other downloadable fonts. Otherwise your PostScript printer may burp or vomit, due to memory restrictions. Some characters should be used only at sizes of 48 points or greater. A very rough picture of the keycaps of DavysOtherDingbats is as follows: REGULAR KEYBOARD-SHIFT KEYBOARD-The above characters are 29.9 point characters as drawn by ATM in Adobe Illustrator. Sorry they get cut off, but what can ya do? DavysOtherDingbats is \_ 1991 by David Rakowski, and is distributed free of charge without request for recompense of any sort. Commercial distribution is, however, strictly prohibited without exception. You may give copies of DavysOtherDingbats to all your friends, providing all four files contained in this archive are included and in the same folder. DavysOtherDingbats comes to you from Bug-Bytes, who do it for the fun of it.
