- · Export bookmarks to : IBrowse, VoyagerNG, AWeb, Netscape, Opera & Plain Text

1.3 BookCon 1.4a - Requirements

Requirements

This program needs following stuff:

- · An Amiga (ohh gosh, you can't mean that) :-)
- · AmigaDOS 2.04 or higher..
- · Asl.library...
- ' "button.gadget" under "SYS:Classes/Gadgets/"

 If you havn't got this, get a democopy of the ClassAct by Finale-Development.

 Can be found under the URL http://www.finale-dev.com
- · 3.x or higher to use the locale-support (not required).

That's it !.. And a little memory to :-)

This program has been tested on following systems with success:

Amiga 4000 (AmigaDOS 3.1, CyberStorm MkII, CV3D, 2 Mb Chip/64 Mb Fast)

Installation

Place the program where ever you want... That's about it...

If you want to use any other language then english (built in)
 - start "language_install".. and choose between 6 different languages.
The installer will install it under "SYS:Locale/catalogs", if possible.
 If there is any problems with this, please contact me...
Notice! the locale support needs AmigaDOS 3.0 or higher to work...
 I will add a proper installer in next release...
1.5 BookCon 1.4a - Usage
Usage
 1. Pick the file you want to convert to another format.. (format will be
   controlled automatically)
 2. Choose what kind of format you want to export it to (use the cycle-gadget)
 3. Pick the outgoing file..
 4. Press on the "Convert" button, and if it's a valid bookmark there would
   be no troubles ...
 (5.) If you use the program the same way everytime (same path's & file's),
     you can press on the "Settings" button and from there you can
     save the current settings or change them...The saved changes will be
     there as default ( so no more hard ASL-clicking :-) )
 If you are going to use PC/MAC bookmarks, remember to "filter" them through
CrossDOS or CrossMAC so they work OK... (if you have any problems with them)
Keyboard-shortcuts:
All shortcuts are underlined except the "Export-type"-cycle-gadget
which has the shortcut "x".
```

Tooltypes

4 different tooltypes are supported:

```
CONVERT = Converts as if the "convert"-button where pressed.

CONVERT&QUIT = Converts and tries to quit the program.

OVERWRITE = Overwrite if the destination file already exists.

NOREQ = Make the "Quit" and "Conversion-Ready" requester not to "pop"-up.
```

The tooltypes are all disabled from beginning (use info from Workbench to check/change this)

Quit = Tries to quit the program.
```

Convert = Converts as if the "convert"-button where pressed.

About = Shows the about-requester (dunno why this is a feature) ;-)

The ARexx-support is not tested, so don't rely to much on it. It will be better support for this in the future...

- · This version is just a fix for the latest version!
- · Forgot to disable the tooltype-functions.

The program tried to Convert and quit..

And if you haven't used the program before, it acted kinda strange because it didn't find any prefs-file...

The tooltypes should look like this when they are disabled :

(CONVERT|CONVERT&QUIT)
(OVERWRITE)
(NOREQ)

· Removed a bug in the Opera-saver (minor).
