1.2 Introduction

Introduction

The PrinterStyle is freeware.

THIS PROGRAM CAN NOT CHANGE THE INTERNAL SETTING'S ON THE PRINTER.

This program was originally written to test a GUI that was font sensitive.

That was the 1st reason the 2nd was to change the output styles on the Canon BJC-4100 inkjet printer, as this printer has no buttons on it's front panel to change the print style (font, colour, pitch, etc) but should work on any Epson compatible printer.

All output to the printer is sent via the PAR: device, and this by-passes the conversion process done by the PRT: device, so some characters will not be printed correctly (ie £ © etc..).

I use this program to print out my 'C' source code in a LQ font for a final hardcopy, this can not be done on CED 3.5 as there is no way I know to change the font. My previous printer(Panasonic 2123 could lock the fonts).

The window has

6 **Cycle** gadgets

3 sets of **Check** boxes

2 **Slider** gadgets

6 **Button** gadgets

1.3 Cycle Gadgets

The cycle gadgets control the following:

Fonts Draft, Roman, Gothic, Courier, Prestige, Script.

Colour Black, Magenta, Cyan, Blue, Yellow, Red, Green.

LF Spacing 1/6 inch (66 lines/page), 1/8 inch (72 lines/page).

Width/Height .. Normal, Double Wide, Double High, Double Wide+High.

Script Mode ... Normal, Super Script, Sub Script.

Int Char Set .. Usa, France, Germany, UK, Denmark 1, Sweden, Italy,

Spain 1, Japan, Norway, Denmark 2, Spain 2,

Latin America, Korea, Legal.

1.4 Check Box Gadgets

The check box gadgets control the following:

Pitch (10cpi Pica, 12cpi Elite, 15cpi Fine) + 17cpi Condensed.

Style 1 ... Plain, Bold + Italic + Underlined.

Style 2 ... Normal, Outline + Shadow + Proportional spacing.

1.5 Slider Gadgets

The slider gadgets control the following:

Left & Right Margins ... Ranging from 1 > 150. The Left slider will not exceed the current Right slider.

1.6 Button Gadgets

The button gadgets do the following:

Line Feed If paper is not loaded loads paper & feeds 1 line.

If paper is loaded 1st click sends LF code to printer, next click feeds paper 1 line and stores the LF code in the printers internal buffer.

Form Feed Prints any data in the printers internal buffer & ejects paper.

Print File ... Brings up an ASL Load File Requester & allows you to select a file

to print using the current settings shown in the window.

Send Sends the current settings shown in the window to the printer.

If you want to send a file to the printer using these settings
make sure you send it to the PAR: device as the PRT: device
resets the printer to the default settings in the Workbench:

Printer.Prefs.

Test Sends the current settings shown in the window to the printer.

Then prints the settings & prints some characters using the
settings.

Quit Quits PrinterStyle !
