## rt scripts

The entire state of a scratchpad can be saved to a simple ascii file with file type .rt. This is done from the documents submenu, and if it is a new scratchpad, you will be prompted for a filename. Similarly, you can restore a mix by first opening a new scratchpad and then opening a .rt file from the documents submenu. (If you get really tired of interfaces you can even run a mix from the driver directly by directing that script into the driver itself, e.g. rt.driver < myscript.rt. You do this from a terminal window. The command to play is mix(start,end)). The .rt script will save and restore the state of your **tracks window** as well.
