Installation Instructions

Since you are now reading this document, you must have already loaded the Black Dog Cribbage files onto your system. To complete the installation process, you just need to tell the Windows Program Manager how to find Black Dog Cribbage. Here's how to do that:

These instructions assume that when you copied this software to your system, you copied it to a subdirectory called "C:\BDCRIB". If you copied this software somewhere else, you will need to adjust the directory name as noted below.

- 1) Open your Games group in program manager. If it was already open, just click on the title bar to make sure it is the active group.
- 2) On the Program Manager menu, click the "File" menu item, then click "New".
- 3) A "New Program Object" dialog box will appear. Check the "Program Item" option if it is not already checked, and then click "OK".
- 4) A "Program Item Properties" dialog box will appear. Complete the information as follows:

Description: Black Dog Cribbage

Command Line: C:\BDCRIB\CRIB.EXE (change the drive and directory name

"C:\BDCRIB" to whatever subdirectory you copied this

software to.

Leave the other fields as they are, and click "OK".

The Black Dog Cribbage icon will appear in your Games group.

program.

README.WRI this file.

Setup Notes

If you use 256 color video drivers on your system, you may find that this program runs very slowly. If this is the case, you may need to get updated Windows video drivers for your video card. I found that this game ran terribly slow when using the older (1990) 256 color video driver for my ATI card, yet ran fine with the 16 color video driver installed. I installed more recent (1992) video drivers, and the difference in speed of this game and other programs was incredible. If you have problems running this game (or other programs) in 256 color mode, you may want to check with your video card vendor on the availability of updated Windows video drivers.
