This full motion live-action interactive title was first released on Sega CD in 1992 and was one of the two top-selling Sega CD titles that year. A 3D0 version was released earlier this year. "Night Trap" became embroiled in controversy last December when it was targeted by Senators Lieberman (D-Conn.) and Kohl (D-Wis.) as an example of violence in video games during the Senate sub-committee hearings.

As in the original, the Mac version of "Night Trap" is 100% full motion interactive video.
