The 7th Guest: Part III, to be released in the fall of 97, will offer feature-film quality, full-motion video and 3D graphical environments in a puzzle-based game that takes players into the world of demented toy maker, Henry Stauf.

It's official, Turner Broadcasting System Inc's TBS Superstation and Turner Network Television have purchased exclusive rights to 101 motion pictures from Viacom Inc's Paramount Pictures.
