Read Me First!

All CDs should contain the following folders:

- Visual Basic 6 Update
- Windows Library Update
- *Internet Explorer 5.X*
- Web-O-Rama Standard 7.X Full (latest release version)
- Web-O-Splash

If you have purchased Web-O-Rama Professional, the CD should also contain the following folder:

• Web-O-Rama Pro 7.X Full (latest release version)

Description of folder contents

- ◆ Visual Basic 6 Update is a Microsoft update to system files necessary for smooth installation of Visual Basic 6 programs. Double-click vbrun60sp3.exe to install. Installing this file is particularly important if you are using Windows 95.
- ◆ Windows Library Update is a Microsoft recommended update to certain important system files. Double-click SPEU.exe to install.
- ◆ Internet Explorer 5 is version 5.0 or 5.1 of IE5. Double-click ie5setup.exe to install. If you are presented with a screen that implies you need to connect to the Internet and download IE5, this is not actually the case. Choose the components you want to install and click through the screens. The installation screens are not terribly intuitive.
- ◆ Web-O-Rama Standard 7.X Full contains the full installation of Web-O-Rama Standard (the standard version does not include the "Web View" tab). Install by running setup.exe from the CD (Start → Run → locate setup.exe on CD) or by copying the contents of Web-O-Rama Standard Full to an empty folder on the primary partition (usually C:\) of your hard drive and double-clicking setup.exe.
- ♦ Web-O-Splash is a small utility designed to disable Web-O-Rama's splash screen from outside the program if Web-O-Rama locks up the first time you try to it. A few people have reported this problem. It seems to occur most often on machines running NT 4 with older graphics cards. Web-O-Splash will not run if you have not installed Web-O-Rama. Web-O-Splash requires no installation; merely double-click the .exe file to disable Web-O-Rama's splash screen.
- ◆ Web-O-Rama Pro 7.X Full (if you have purchased Web-O-Rama Professional) contains the full installation of Web-O-Rama Professional. See Web-O-Rama Standard Full. above. for installation instructions.

If you are using *Windows 95*, it is recommended that you install the supplemental files in the order below, rebooting after each installation whether the computer asks you to or not. It is also a good idea to delete the contents of *Windows \ Temp* before installing any program and between installations of the supplemental files.

- Visual Basic 6 Update
- Windows Library Update

• Internet Explorer 5 (needed for Web-O-Rama Professional; otherwise, install only if you have problems installing or running Web-O-Rama)

If you already have *Internet Explorer 5*, running the *IE5* installation will only confirm that you have the latest files and will not alter your current installation if it is up-to-date.

If you are using *Windows 98* or *Windows 98 SE*, installing the above files is not necessary unless you have problems installing or running *Web-O-Rama*.

If you are using *Windows 2000*, your system files should be current and you should not have to install the files listed above.

Users of *NT 4*, with service pack *SP1*, *SP2*, or *SP3* installed, should probably install all of the above files (as well as *SP3*). If you have installed *SP4*, *SP5*, or *SP6*, you probably do not need any of the above files. *Web-O-Rama* will not work with versions of *NT* lower than v. 4.0. You need to be logged on as *Administrator* to install *Web-O-Rama* on *NT*.

A *very small* number of people have reported being unable to successfully install *Web-O-Rama*. If this happens, please contact me immediately for a full refund.
