- **StartUp v2.8.XP** (let you see what applications starts with your computer a gives the possibily to change it)
- **AviC FourCC Changer** (to chage the header of an avi file)
- **GSPot v2.21** (shows information about an .avi, codecs, resolution...)
- **Media Player Classic v6.4.8.2 FR & US** (media player supports all popular formats: QuickTime, RealMedia, WMV, DivX...)
- **MUSK Media Player v0.5.65 FR** (new media player by MUSK)
- **MUSK Filter/Codec Enumerator v1.2 FR & US** (Same as SysEnum but this one let you fix problems, by MUSK)

User's manual:

If you know nothing about codecs, all you have to install to read all movies in avi format is:

DivX 5.1.1 Pro  
XviD  
OGG Vorbis  
AC3 Filtre  
DivXG400 (ou DirectVobSub)  
Morgan Stream Switcher

With these codecs, you will be able to read all DivX, XviD films, and those that uses multi-sound tracks

and the films avec Dolby Sound.

To read QuickTime files without installing the QuickTime player, just install QuickTime codecs, and use Media Player Classi to read all the QuickTime Files (.qt/.mov).

To read Real Media files (RV9 included) you will have to install RealMedia Codec (RV9) and RealMediaSplitter to be able to read these files in Windows Media Player or other players that uses the DirectShow.

For the rest, if you dont know them, it means that you dont need them :)

The FFDSHow filter is used to play DivX, XviD, WMV, MPEG and others formats without having another codec installed. It's quite usefull if you dont want to install several codecs...
