

## Chickens Saver setup

Use this dialog box to change the settings for the "Chickens" screen saver. The "Chickens" screen saver features demented poultry on the warpath against your desktop.

## **Egging Speed**

▶ This value determines how frequently bitmaps show up on the screen. The scroll bar allows settings from "continuously" to "almost never."

## **Eggs Density**

▶ This value determines the number of eggs which will be "thrown" on your desktop before the next chicken appears. The scroll bar allows settings from "very light" to "very heavy" corresponding to 2 eggs to 100 eggs respectively.

## **Animation Speed**

▶ Selects how fast the chickens perform their shenanigans. The scroll bar allows settings from "snail pace" to "warp speed."

## Sound

▶ If this box is checked, and you have a sound driver installed, you may hear various sound effects generated by crashing eggs, etc.

**Clear Screen**

▶ If this box is checked, the screen will be "blanked out" or cleared to black before the first egg is thrown. Leave the box unmarked to display everything right on you desktop.
