What's UnScrollly ?

UnScrollly is a cdev which allows you to choose between 2 lists format in the Control Panel Desk Accessory.

The usual “icons” format which 4 devices visible at one, a new “names” format with 20 devices visible at once.

How to install UnScrollly ?

Simply drag it in your system folder ! (no INIT, no patch)
