Trap Shooting for Windows requires that a 'Small Font' video driver be loaded for resolutions of 800x600 or higher. Some video card manufacturers (Western Digital and Diamond especially) distribute incorrect Small Font drivers with their cards, causing graphics problems to occur. If the game behaves erratically, or looks funny, switch to standard VGA. If this clears up the problem, then the drivers are at fault. Contact your video card manufacturer for their latest drivers.
