

BlackHole III Documentation

Hi! This is, in case you haven't guessed, yet another black hole trash can replacement. But there is a big difference between mine and the other ones. Well, two differences. But the big one is mine works with System 7.x!! The other

difference is mine is shareware. **WAIT!!** Don't quit and throw away the package yet. Hear me out. I am asking a mere \$1.00 fee. US Dollars. I think it's worth it. Plus if you pay, you get tech support. No pay, no way. So, if you install this incorrectly and you're computer starts belching and blowing chunks (this is *very* unlikely, but other bad things can happen), and the check isn't in the mail (my fee, that is), don't come crying to me. However, pay, and I'll do anything and everything I can to help you with any Mac related problem you may have. That's right, not only things pertaining to BlackHole III, but *any problem*. Free computer consulting!!! Well, almost free. So, support shareware, support me, and get support.

OK, now to the matter of installing BlackHole III. This requires Apple's wonderful utility, ResEdit. We computer genius types are required by Federal law to give the following warning whenever ResEdit is mentioned: *ALWAYS WORK ON COPIES!!!!!!* Ok, using ResEdit, open a *copy* of the System file. Now open the file "BlackHole III-System Stuff." Select all the resources in it and select "Copy." Click in the System file window. Paste. select "Yes" in the dialog box that appears. Save & Close the System file. Close the other file. Open a *copy* of the Finder file. Open the file "BlackHole III-FinderStuff." Do the same as above, except substitute "Finder" wherever you see "System." Drag the unmodified System & Finder files to the Trash. Place the modified ones in the System Folder. Restart. Ta-Da!!! A Black Hole is on your desktop!

How to send me money:
