## General Information

"GigaCat" is System 7 compatible. Please be sure you give the majority of your remaining memmory (REMAINING AMOUNT found under "About this Macintosh...") in order to afford GigaCat the maximum space to manipulate your files. This can be accomplished by pressing ⌘ -I after activating the GigaCat icon then changing the bottom memory size. "GigaCat" also works with the MultiFinder, but does not provide background modes (such as sorting in the backgound). We suggest you use, "GigaCat" with the Finder since it affords "GigaCat" the maximum amount of workspace whereby allowing the maximum numbers of files and/or volumes to be maintained.

This program has been tested on the Macintosh Plus, SE, SE/30, Mac II, IIx, IIcx, IIci, IIfx, LC, IIsi, Mac Portable, Powerbook 100, 140, 170 and has also been tested with the Rapport/Drive 2.4, plus numerous makes of Removable Cartridge and CD-ROM Drives. It has been noted that some brands of Removable Cartridge Drives will not respond to the Auto Eject setting in the Preferences window. This requires you to manually mount and eject these drives. GigaCat cannot be made to do this automatically since the drivers written for them do not use standard system calls with the Apple Macintosh Operating System. We regret this inconvenience for some users, but you must direct your complains to the Removable Cartridge manufacturer.
