

What's New In Version 2.0

Version 2.0 is the result of my giving JPEGView a major facelift. The major new features include color quantization, GIF support, and reorganized preferences and help interfaces. A more precise summary of the extensive changes incorporated into Version 2.0 is given in the Program History section. If you have used any previous versions of JPEGView, it is recommended that you review the freshly-written documentation, and the sections on Colors And Quantization and Preferences Settings in particular. In addition, you will almost definitely benefit by reading the two Questions & Answers sections and the Hints And Tips section, which together provide a lot of new and useful information on using JPEGView effectively.

Once again, I am releasing JPEGView as postcardware, meaning that if you use it, I'd really, really like it if you sent me a postcard of your hometown or of where you are currently living — even if it's "just" Chicago, or "just" Schaumburg, or "just" wherever...send them anyways! As an author committed to providing a good, solid image viewer for the Macintosh absolutely free of charge, it is very difficult for me to know what everyone thinks of my application, or who is using it, or even how many people use it. A simple postcard would not only remedy the situation but would also provide me with additional encouragement for continuing to improve JPEGView in the future.
