## **Quality User Supported Extensions To The Hermes BBS**

This file contains information about the latest versions of programs available now in the **CT Extensions Pak #1**. This offer includes five (5) separate programs for the ridiculously low price of \$17.50. The programs are mailed to you on a Master Disk and your purchase entitles you to free updates to all five (5).

**Special Offer Until June 1, 1991**: Those orders for **CT Extensions Pak #1** which are received prior to June 1st will receive an additional extension *FREE OF CHARGE*. (I don't want to 'let the cat out of the bag' quite yet about the nature of this extension, but it is under development and testing at this time and should be very well received. After June 1st, it will be included in the new CT Extensions Pak #2.)

#### Validity 1.6 Automatic New Caller Validation!

Validity takes control after a new caller has completed the initial stages of logging on to a Hermes BBS. Validity is designed to handle much of the mundane aspects of managing a Hermes BBS while providing some additional and necessary information about your callers. It performs these functions automatically, efficiently, yet with a level of configurability which will allow the SysOp to customize its operation.

## **Feature List**

1] Saves new caller information in up to four (4) report formats.

2] Automatically adjusts Security Level, Download Security Level, Message Forum Access, and Restrictions based upon new caller responses.

3] Optionally grant credit to new callers for Messages Posted, Number of Uploads, and Kilobytes Uploaded.

4] At completion of Validity, the new caller is displayed 1 of 3 special files, based upon the Security Level which Validity (and the SysOp) assigned them. This feature is useful when providing different levels of accessibility on the same BBS.

5] "Agreement" file display. Automatic ANSI or TEXT display of all files

6] Forced responses. Validity offers new callers several opportunities to provide the requested information at important data-gathering points. If the caller tries to bypass this, they will be automatically logged off and Hermes resets for the next caller.

7] AUDIO ALERTS!! Validity plays special sounds through the Macintosh's speaker at important points in its operation.

Validity was the first Hermes BBS external to utilize the Sound Manager!!

8] Remote operation. Validity is configurable either logged on locally or by calling in form remote..

## <u>List'r 1.3</u> Takes The Drudgery Out Of The Creation of File Lists!

List'r takes the work out of creating listings of the files available on your Hermes BBS. List'r catalogs the important information about the files and stores them to locations and filenames of the SysOp's choosing. List'r can save a listing of the entire contents of your file sections, or it can save a list based upon a search using variable criteria.

Callers can also use the on-screen report feature to view the files which they have contributed to your BBS.

# Feature List

1] Saves complete listing of all files on your BBS Saves listing of files uploaded within the past variable number of days—the number of days you

can choose is between 1 and 999. Also saves listing of files which are OLD (have been on your system for many days, but have been downloaded only a few times) and DEAD (have not been downloaded in quite a while).

2] Creates on-screen listings of files. This feature can be used by caller and sysop.

3] All file listings (saved to disk or on-screen) are based upon Download Security Level and Restrictions. Callers who do not have access to various transfer sections will not see them in their search—you can include all or part of your library in the listings..

4] Special header and footer messages of up to five (5) lines each can be included in all listings saved to disk—configurable by the SysOp.

5] Remote operation. List'r is configurable either logged on locally or by calling in from remote.

## BullReader 1.5.2 Bulletin Reader Displays TEXT Files At Log-On!

BullReader displays a Daily Bulletin to a caller on their first call of the day. In addition to the Daily Bulletin, BullReader will display 1 of 3 special Auto Bulletins to your callers.

## Feature List

1] Displays a bulletin of the SysOp's choosing once per day or, optionally, on each logon. The display of the Daily Bulletin can be either forced or prompted. The text of the prompt is configurable by the SysOp.

2] One of three special Auto Bulletins may be displayed to the caller. The display is based on Security Level and the ranges are configurable by the SysOp.

3] All bulletins can be displayed either always or only on the first call of the day. Automatic ANSI or TEXT display of the bulletins.

4] Remote operation.

## End'r 1.5.1 Log-off Usage Report Generator!

End'r displays a report to the caller at log-off containing information about the number of times the caller has called your system, number of minutes on, number of uploads, number of downloads, and number of e-mail and public messages posted.

A special message is displayed at the end of the report which reflects the contribution that the caller has, or has not made to your BBS. The text of this message is configurable by the SysOp.

## Feature List

1] End'r offers three different report formats — (wide, long, and short)

2] The report is automatically displayed at log-off and, optionally, can be displayed from the Externals List.

3] Remote operation. End'r is configurable either logged on locally or by calling in from remote.

#### <u>Report'r 1.0</u> System Settings Report Generation!

Report'r generates report listings of important settings in the Hermes BBS. Settings for all configurable items are included in the reports. The areas that Report'r presently creates listings for are: Message Forum Subs, Transfer Sections, and Security Levels. (Expect an upgrade soon!! User Reports!!!)

## **Feature List**

1] All configurable settings are included in the reports.

- 2] Handy, easy-to-read columnar format.
- 3] Remote operation.
