There are many places where figures are useful. See figure «#doodle» for complete details.

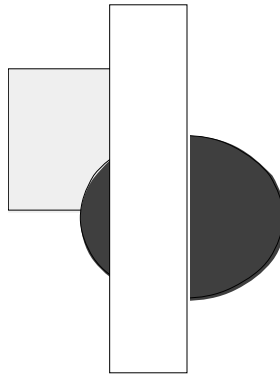
