PM4 ShortCuts is a desk accessory to be used in conjunction with PageMaker 4.0 for the Macintosh. It contains a list of all of PageMaker's keyboard shortcuts, as well as some undocumented features, and can be pulled down from the Apple menu within PageMaker. PM4 ShortCuts may be installed with the Font/DA Mover $^{\text{TM}}$ or with a utility such as SuitCase II^{TM} .

When you open PM4 ShortCuts, you will be in the help screen. There are nine other screens of information that you can quickly access by clicking on the appropriate button at the bottom of the help screen.

These nine other screens of shortcuts and features are:
Text--shortcuts for changing type specifications
Kern--kerning shortcuts and kern-pair information
Edit--shortcuts for edit and options menu commands
Cursor--shortcuts for moving the insertion point and selecting text
Special Characters--a list of extended characters and typographical characters
Metacharacters--a list of metacharacters for Finding and Changing
Page--shortcuts for moving around in publication, changing page views and palettes
Tools--shortcuts for changing tools and manipulating objects
Miscellaneous--power user and unknown shortcuts
