Cowboy Cody

Animated Cursor Set Version 1.0 Installation Instructions

Congratulations! You've just downloaded the neatest little set of animated cursors around. Just follow the installation procedures, and you'll be on your way to using Cowboy Cody.

(Reminder: If you don't have Windows® 95 or Windows NTTM, then you can't use Cowboy Cody. Sorry!)

From the downloaded self-extracting file "Cody10.exe", you received the following files:

Cowboy Cody Setup.wri: The text file you are now reading. It contains the installation procedures for the Cowboy Cody Animated Cursor Set

Order Form.wri: An Order Form for purchasing the full set of the Cowboy Cody Animated Cursor Set

Catalog.wri A catalog file listing the cursor sets available from K 'n S Associates. Along with the cursor set names, the file includes catalog numbers, unit prices, and color pictures to represent the cursors.

Cowboy Cody Full Set.zip: A compressed file containing the full set of 14 Cowboy Cody cursors (requires a password to decompress) Cowboy Cody Normal Select.ani: Demo cursor used for normal pointing.

Cowboy Cody Text Select.ani: Demo cursor used for text selection. Cowboy Cody Diagonal Resize 1.ani: Demo cursor used for resizing a window diagonally.

The following is a list of the Windows® 95 (also for NT 4.0) and Windows NTTM (version 3.51 or below) cursor/pointer types for which the demo cursor files would best be used (these are only suggestions):

To purchase a <u>full</u> version of the Cowboy Cody Animated Cursor Set, or any of the cursor sets, print and fill out the order form located in the file "Order Form.wri" and mail it along with either a check or money order today. (Sorry, we do not accept credit cards.) You will then be emailed a password for each set you order that will enable you to unzip (decompress) the file containing the full set of cursors. Or, if you prefer, you may order an uncompressed version of the cursor sets which you will receive via U.S. Mail on a floppy disk (U.S. orders only).

If you do not already have WinZip® 6.1, you can download an evaluation version from the WinZip® Internet site at http://www.winzip.com. Instructions for Extracting Files from a zip archive can be found in the **Brief Tutorial** under the WinZip® **Help** pull-down menu.

Cursor Installation Procedures for Windows® 95 & NT 4.0

(Note: If you need additional help to install your cursors, you may refer to our illustrated setup procedures available on the Internet at http://www.hsv.tis.net/~slmartin/Setup.htm or email your questions to us at slmartin@traveller.com.)

1) To install the free Cowboy Cody demo cursors, go on to step 2). If you have ordered the full set of Cowboy Cody cursors and received your password, continue with step 1) to decompress the full set.

Open the file "Cowboy Cody Full Set.zip" using WinZip®. Click on the WinZip® **Options** pull-down menu and click on **Password**. Enter the password you received via email, then click **OK**. Extract all fourteen of the full version files into any folder (the Windows Cursors folder would probably be best).

- 2) Open the **Control Panel** by either:
 - a) Click on Start, select Settings, click on Control Panel, or
 - b) Double click on **My Computer**, then double click on **Control Panel**
- 3) Double click on **Mouse**
- 4) Select the **Pointers** tab
- 5) For each of the cursor/pointer types listed above for Windows® 95 (three for the demo or fourteen for the full set):
 - a) Select the pointer type (e.g., **Normal Select**)
 - b) Click the **Browse** button
 - c) Change to the directory (folder) in which you extracted your cursor files.
 - d) Find and select the Cowboy Cody file that corresponds to the pointer type selected in 5a.
 - e) Click Open
- 6) To save this pointer scheme:
 - a) Click the Save As button
 - b) Type in a name for your scheme in the **Save Scheme** dialog box (e.g., Animated Cowboy Cody)
 - c) Click OK
- 7) Click **OK** to close the **Mouse Properties** window and begin enjoying Cowboy Cody!

Cursor Installation Procedures for Windows NTTM

1) To install the free Cowboy Cody demo cursors, go on to step 2). If you have ordered the full set of Cowboy Cody cursors and received your password, continue with step 1) to decompress the full set.

Open the file "Cowboy Cody Full Set.zip" using WinZip®. Click on the WinZip® **Options** pull-down menu and click on **Password**. Enter the password you received via email, then click **OK**. Extract all fourteen of the full version files into any folder (the Windows Cursors folder would probably be best).

- 2) Double click the Main group, double click Control Panel
- 3) Double click on Cursors
- 4) For each of the cursor types listed above for Windows NTTM (three for the demo or fourteen for the full set):
 - a) Select the cursor type (e.g., Arrow)
 - b) Click the **Browse** button
 - c) Change to the directory (folder) in which you extracted your cursor files.
 - d) Find and select the Cowboy Cody file that corresponds to the cursor type selected in 4a.
 - e) Click **OK**
- 5) To save this cursor scheme:
 - a) Click the **Save Scheme** button
 - b) Type in a name for your scheme in the **Save Scheme** dialog box (e.g., Animated Cowboy Cody)
 - c) Click OK
- 6) Click **OK** to close the **Cursors** window and begin enjoying Cowboy Cody!
