The program on this disk is version 3.4 of our Windows audio CD Player Lite. It provides complete control over the playing of audio CDs and the ability to catalogue your collection.

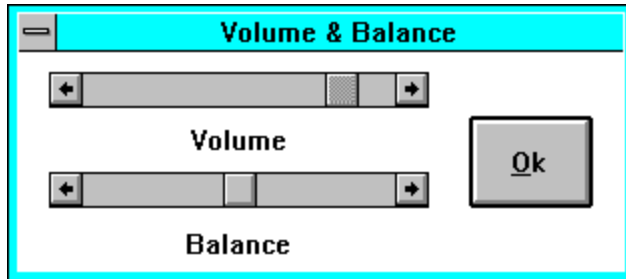
You can upgrade to the full PRO version of CDPlayer by printing and completing the file ORDER.FRM and send it to Jupiter Software or one of our agents.

Additional features contained in CDPlayer PRO:

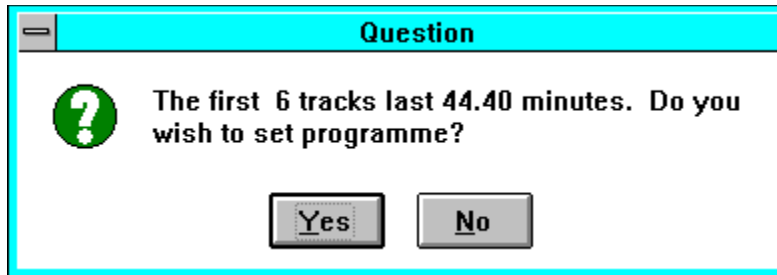
- 1 Extended track titles - 100 characters!
- 2 Browse CD catalogue - Allows you to list and scroll through your CD catalogue and select discs for viewing and editing even if they are not currently being played.
- 3 Search facility - allowing you to search your catalogue for a given disc, track title or composer. Display a list of discs matching the search pattern and view edit the record.
- 4 On screen volume control.



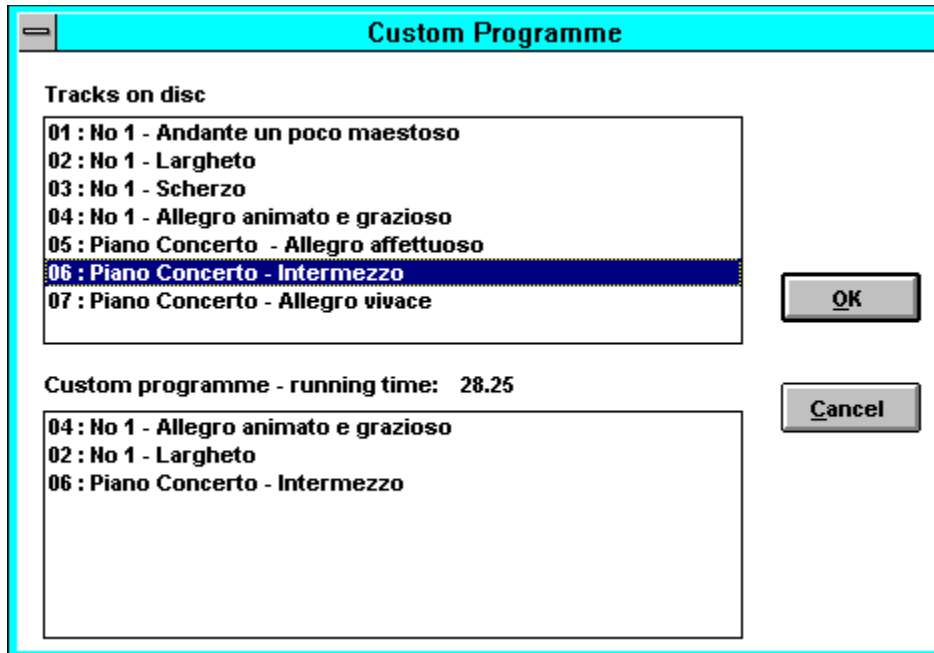
- 5 Data import and export - allowing you to import details of your CDs from an existing database and export them to a database program for printing. Saves the need to enter details of your CDs if you already have them in a database.
- 6 Small Handset - small enough to have displayed on the screen while working in other programs.



- 7 Fit track to time - useful for recording to tape.



- 8 Enter/edit custom play from a pick list.



- 9 Jump to track using a pick list.
10 Select CD drive to play.
11 Delete unwanted records.

MEMORY RESIDENT CD PLAYER

Upgrade users will receive an unrestricted copy of CDtsr(TM), a memory resident CD player. This program allows DOS users, who are running text based programs, to pop up a CD handset similar to that contained in CDPlayer(TM). This is very handy for pausing the CD to take a phone call, carrying on with your current application and then resuming play by popping up the handset a second time. Also for playing a new CD without having to close down your current application.
