

NOTE: Before the EasyMail Server is run for the first time, it is important to use the EasyMail Administrator program to open the server first by selecting "Open Server" from the "Sharing" menu. If you do not, your server will not be shared over the network.

If you are having trouble accessing your EasyMail Server over the network using your EasyMail Client, then:

- Open your EasyMail Administrator.
- Close your EasyMail Server by selecting "Close Server" from the "Sharing" menu.
- Open your EasyMail Server by selecting "Open Server" from the "Sharing" menu.
- Quit the EasyMail Administrator.

The reason for this is that System 7 File Sharing sometimes screws up and resets the sharing preferences for each volume. This ensures that the settings are correct.

NOTE: You cannot use an EasyMail Server for other File Sharing or use with AppleShare File Server. This is because of the way EasyMail accesses the main server.
