NOTE:

The à, á, â, ä and ÿ characters are overstrikes. In each case, the first two are for short letters and the next three for tall. Use a and o for normal width letters, e and u for wide letters, and i only for the very narrow letters, i, j, l, and Æ. A good rule of thumb in choosing an overstrike: what looks best on the screen will likely look best in the LaserWriter output.
