

The Braille character set is lowercase only. To capitalize a character, place the capitalization character (consisting of only dot 6) before the character you want to capitalize. To capitalize an entire word, place two capitalization characters before the start of the word. Digits 1 through 0 are the characters a through j; put a single number sign (consisting of dots 3, 4, 5, and 6) before the first digit in a number to distinguish it from a word.
