

The April/May 1939 issue of EERIE MYSTERIES was the last in its four issue run. It is likely that all of the authors listed were pseudonyms and that most, if not all, of the stories were reprints from other Ace magazines. This may help explain why, in spite of several nice covers by Norman Saunders, neither EERIE MYSTERIES nor any of the Ace weird menace titles were able to compete with the weird menace pulps being published by Popular Publications, HORROR STORIES, TERROR TALES, DIME MYSTERY MAGAZINE and DIME DETECTIVE. Apparently the "10 Complete Horror Thrillers" were not thrilling enough.
