

Robert Leslie Bellem cops the cover of the February 1935 issue of SPICY DETECTIVE STORIES with "Alibi Of Death", appearing under his Jerome Severs Perry penname. This was only one of three tales by Bellem present there, as the issue also featured "Death On Location" (with Bellem's by-line) and "Fog Over Limehouse" (attributed to Ellery Watson Calder). "Death On Location" featured Bellem's most famous spicy creation, Dan Turner, who would soon be given his own magazine, and who's adventures are still being reprinted sporadically today. "Death On Location" was reprinted in DAN TURNER--HOLLYWOOD DETECTIVE, published in 1990 by Malibu Graphics, Inc. and edited by Turner fan, and pop culture historian, John Wooley. In addition to "Death On Location", this book reprints two other Dan Turner stories, 3 Dan Turner comic strips, and features an article on the Dan Turner movie that appeared in the early 1990's.
