

Corel Print Office Setup

The Corel Setup Wizard will install the components of Corel Print Office.

Click the Next button to continue to the next step. You can click the Cancel button at any time to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Corel Print Office license agreement

You must accept the terms of the Corel Print Office license agreement to install the product. If you click the Decline button, the Corel Setup Wizard will close and your installation will be canceled.

When you click the Accept button, the Corel Setup Wizard will advance to the next step in the installation. You can click the Back button to return to the previous step or the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

User information

The Corel Setup Wizard records user information for registration purposes.

If you purchased this copy of Corel Print Office for your personal use, enable the Myself button and type the required information in the boxes.

If your company purchased this copy of Corel Print Office for business use, enable the My Company button and type the required information in the boxes.

After you enter the required information, click the Next button to continue. You can click the Back button to return to the previous step or the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Confirmation

The Corel Setup Wizard displays the user information that you entered in the previous step.

If the information displayed is correct, click the Next button to continue.

You can click the Back button to return to the previous step or the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Product serial number

Each copy of Corel Print Office has a unique product serial number.

Type your product serial number in the box, then click the Next button to continue. Click the Back button to return to the previous step to modify the user information.

You can click the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Options

You can choose from two installation types. Typical installs Corel Print Office, Corel Photo House and Corel Colleagues & Contacts. This is the best choice for most users. Custom allows you to select which applications you wish to install, and provides the option of installing additional fonts and language writing tools. You may also specify the destination path for the Borland Database Engine which is required by Corel Colleagues & Contacts.

Enable the appropriate button to choose an installation type, then click the Next button to continue.

You can click the Back button to return to the previous step or the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Components

You can customize your Corel Print Office installation by choosing components to install. The amount of disk space required by the selected components is displayed below the component description.

Enable the check box next to a component to include it the current installation. When you have selected the components to include in this installation, click the Next button to continue.

You can click the Back button to return to the previous step or the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Fonts

A font is a collection of characters (letters, numerals, punctuation marks, and symbols) that share a common design theme, for example, Times New Roman.

The Fonts screen allows you to choose which fonts you want to install. Although we provide you with hundreds of fonts to choose from, we recommend that you select a limited number of fonts to work with; 500 or more installed fonts may adversely affect your computer's performance.

You can view the fonts by group or by name; simply click the Display Fonts By Groups button. To expand a group, double-click the group name or click the plus sign beside its name.

To add or remove a font or group of fonts, click the check box beside its name. When a check-mark appears in the check box, the font or font group is selected for installation; a check-mark in a shaded box indicates that some parts of a font are selected, and a blank check box indicates that the font is not selected. A red check mark indicates that the font must be selected.

As you add or subtract fonts from the list, the total number of selected fonts, and the total disk space required, is displayed at the bottom of the Fonts dialog box.

When you have selected the components to include in this installation, click the Next button to continue. You can click the Back button to return to the previous step or the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Destination folders

The Corel Setup Wizard will install the Corel Print Office application files into the specified folder(s) by default. You can change the destination folder.

The Disk Space Information area displays the space required by the Corel Print Office files and the remaining space on each of the specified drives.

Click the Browse button or type the path to choose a different destination folder, then click the Next button to continue.

You can click the Back button to return to the previous step or the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Shortcuts

You can choose the folder for the Print Office shortcuts. Shortcuts appear on the Start menu and let you have easy access to your applications.

Double-click a folder name from the list to create the shortcuts in a different folder. You can also type a folder name in the box. To keep the default, click the Next button to continue the installation.

When you are satisfied with the shortcut folder, click the Next button to continue. You can click the Back button to return to the previous step or the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.

Ready to install

The Corel Setup Wizard is ready to install the Corel Print Office files.

If you want to make any changes, click the Back button to return to previous steps.

Click the Install button to begin the installation. You can click the Cancel button to abort the installation and close the Corel Setup Wizard.
