IMPORTANT NOTE!

You will need the following information before you install your Pronto Family E-Mail software. If you don't have any part of this information (5 steps listed below) please call your Internet Service Provider (ISP). Examples: AT&T WorldNet, Prodigy, Netcom, etc.

- 1) 'E-mail Address'
 - The address other people on the Internet will be using to send E-mail messages to your family. Examples: lennon@worldnet.att.net, mccartney@ix.netcom.com, etc.
- 2) 'Login Name'
 - Usually the part of your E-mail address prior to the '@' sign. Example: Lennon is the login name of Lennon@worldnet.att.net



- 3) 'Login Password'
 Your login password is given to you by your ISP to protect the privacy of your mailbox
- 4) 'Receiving Mail Server Name'
 Usually called "POP3 server". This is the name your ISP uses to store your incoming Internet mail before you can download it into Pronto Mail. Examples: postoffice.worldnet.att.net, popd.ix.netcom.com, etc. If you don't know your "POP3 Server Name" please call your Internet Service Provider before you install your Pronto Family Mail software.
- 5) 'Sending Mail Server Name'
 Usually called "SMTP Server". This is the name your ISP uses to send your outgoing mail over the Internet. Examples: mailhost.worldnet.att.net, smtp.ix.netcom.com, etc. If you don't know your "SMTP Server Name" please call your Internet Service Provider before you install your Pronto Family Mail software.

If you are using AT&T WorldNet Services we have provided some of the information that you will need.

- Receiving Mail Server Name; postoffice.worldnet.att.net
- Sending Mail Server Name; mailhost.worldnet.att.net
