## WELCOME TO CARD GAME PARTY!

### INTRODUCTION

Hello! The whole McDonaldland gang is feeling stupendously super today because you have come to play cards! Just pick one of the four games and before you know it, you will be playing cards with Birdie, Grimace, CosMc and The Hamburglar! In these games, you can even be your favorite McDonaldland Character! Choose from Crazy Eights, Go Fish, War, Find -a- Card and Mix and Match. You can even paint your own cards.

Pick a game and let's get started!



### MAIN SCREEN

When you enter the program, Ronald is right there to get you started! If you want to hear his introduction again, click on Ronald. If you want to pause the introduction, click anywhere on the screen



Sign in - The first thing you will be asked to do is sign in. Type in your name and click on DONE. Once you have signed in, you're ready to go! You won't be asked to sign in again, so if you would like to sign in a friend, just click on the golden arches and the Sign in prompt will appear.

## OPTIONS MENU

To change your audio, level of difficulty, hints, and card style options, click on the McDonaldland House. This will take you to the Options Menu.

### Audio

Click on the musical notes to highlight them. This turns on the music.

Click on the highlighted notes to turn off the music option.

### Difficulty

Click on the top hamburger to make the games *easy*.

Click on the *second* row of two hamburgers for medium difficulty.

Click on the *third* row of three hamburgers for the ultimate challenge!

### Hints

Would you like to know which card to play next? Just click on the Fry Guy to highlight it. This turns on the Hints option. Want to try it on your own? Click on the highlighted Fry Guy to turn off the hint option.

NOTE: The Hints option applies to Crazy Eights, War, Go Fish, and Find -a- Card.

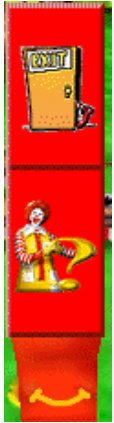


## Card Style Options

Click on the Special Card to highlight it. This will give you playing cards with patterns and designs unique to each game.

Click on the Standard Card to highlight it. This will give you standard playing cards.

## MAIN SCREEN MENU BAR



Click on the Happy Meal Box Menu button in the lower right hand corner of the screen to view the Button bar. The Button bar consists of two options: the Help button and the Exit button. Click on the Help button to repeat Ronald's directions. Click on the Exit button to exit the program. Two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says Yes to Exit the program. Click on the one that says No to stay in the program.

## GAMES MENU BAR



The Games Menu Bar can be accessed from any of the games. It has two buttons: HELP and the McDonaldland Button.



## HELP SCREEN

Click on the Help button for information on playing the game. Click on the McNugget Buddies buttons to learn more about the game. Clicking on the McNugget Buddies Archer will tell you about the Objective of the game. Clicking on the McNugget Buddies Referee will tell you How to Play the game. Last but not least, click on the McNugget Buddies Coach to get hints on Game Strategy.

Help appears in video and text format. There is a MORE button that allows you to find out more about each subject. The AGAIN button that looks like a parrot will repeat what you've just heard.



## McDonaldland Button

Click on the McDonaldland button to exit the game you are playing and return to the McDonaldland screen. Two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to exit the game you are playing and return to the McDonaldland screen. Click on the one that says NO to stay in the program.

## CERTIFICATE MENU BAR

When you win a game, a Congratulations Certificate appears on screen with your name on it. You can print this out by clicking on the Menu button in the lower right hand corner of the screen, and then clicking on the Print button. The print button looks like a smiling printer. You can also click on the Exit button to return to the Game.



## GAME SELECTION

At the Main Screen, you can choose which card game you want to play. To Select a Game:



Click on CosMc's Launching Pad to play War.

Click on the McNugget Babies Nursery School to play Crazy Eights.

Click on McNugget Sauce Lake to play Go Fish.

Click on the Playing Cards to try Find -a- Card.

Click on the statue of Ronald McDonald next to CosMc's Launching Pad to access Mix and Match.

Click on the easel to Paint Your Cards.

*Hint: If you are not sure where a game is located on the screen, move your cursor over the area and Ronald will announce the name of the game.*

---

### To Begin

War, Crazy Eights, and Go Fish allow you to choose the character you want to be and the characters you want to play with. First, click on the character you want to be. You can choose from Grimace, CosMc, Birdie, and Hamburglar. Next, click on one, two or all three of the remaining characters. These will be the characters you are playing with. Click on Ronald McDonald to go to the game.

Find -a- Card - Since this is a single player game, there are no characters to select from or play with.



# FIND -A- CARD

## Objective

To match pairs of cards until all the cards have been matched.

## How to play

1. The game begins with all the cards face down. Click on 2 cards to turn them over and see if you have made a match. If you have a match, both cards will disappear. If not, the cards will turn face down and you can pick another pair.
2. Continue guessing until you have matched all the pairs. You've won when all the cards are gone. At this time, two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to play the game again. Click on the one that says NO to exit the game and return to the McDonaldland screen.

**NOTE:** The number of cards increases in each level of difficulty.

## Strategy

The better your concentration and memorization skills, the more success you'll have with this game, so pay attention!

## Find -a- Card Screen

Viewing area - This is where your cards appear.

Menu Bar - Click here for help or to return to the McDonaldland Screen.

# CRAZY EIGHTS

## Objective

To win this game, you have to get rid of all your cards before the other players get rid of theirs. You get rid of cards by matching ranks: 10 to 10 or 7 to 7 or by matching suits; for example, you can match crayons with crayons.

## How to play

1. The first person to go lays a card face up on top of the balloon by clicking on the card they want to play. Look at the balloon to see the card. When it's your turn, click on the card that you want to play. The card that you play must be the same suit or rank as the card on the balloon. You and your McDonaldland friends will take turns placing cards on the pile.
2. If you do not have a card to play, just click on the pail in the sandbox. If you still can't go, click on the pail again until you get a card you can play.
3. This game is called Crazy Eights because the 8 cards are magic cards. If you don't have a card to play, you can play an eight and make it any suit you want.
4. Whenever you play an eight, the McNugget Babies will start popping up all over the playground. To catch one, just click on it. When you click on the McNugget Baby, a box will appear displaying all our suits. Click on the suit you want. This allows you to change the top card to a suit that matches the most cards in your hand.
5. If you don't have a card to play and all the cards in the central pile have been taken, you can "pass" to the next player by clicking on the Pass button. If no one has a card to play, the game is over.



6. The game is over when one player gets rid of all his cards. At this time, two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to play the game again. Click on the one that says NO to exit the game and return to the McDonaldland screen. If you are the big winner, a Congratulations Certificate appears and you can print it out and show all your friends that you are the champ.

## Strategy

1. Don't use your eights unless you have no other cards to play.
2. Try to play the suits you have the most of in the beginning.

## Crazy Eights Screen

Sand Pail - This is where the cards are.

Balloon - This is where your card is displayed.

Opponent - Click on your opponent to see how many cards he or she has left.

Menu Bar - Click here for help or to return to the McDonaldland Screen.

Hotspots - These are hidden extras that are fun to click on.

Teeter Totter - Click on the teeter totter and it goes up and down.

Sandbox - Click on the sand and a shark fin travels from end to end of the sandbox.

Beach ball - Click on the beach ball and it changes patterns.

Tree in the background - Click on the Tree and it changes patterns.



# WAR

## Objective

To win this game, you must get all of your opponent's cards.

## How to play

1. Click on your down pile of cards to play the first card. The highest card wins all of the cards played. Ace is the highest, then king, queen, jack, ten and so on to two.

2. The war part of the game is started when two or more players play the same card. A floating hamburger will magically appear somewhere on the center of the launch pad. Each player gets a package of condiments and tries to hit the burger first. Just click your mouse when you think you can hit the hamburger. The first player to hit the target wins all the cards played.

3. The game continues until one player has all the cards. At this time, two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to play the game again. Click on the one that says NO to exit the game and return to the McDonaldland screen. If you are the big winner, a Congratulations Certificate appears. You can print it out and show all your friends that you are the champ.



## Strategy

Sorry, no strategy. It's just the luck of the draw.

## War Screen

Deck of Cards - Click here to play your card.

Opponent - Click on your opponent to see how many cards he or she has left.

Menu Bar - Click here for help or to return to the McDonaldland Screen.

Hotspots - These are hidden extras that are fun to click on.

Space Drink Straw- Bubbles appear.

Launch Pad - See a McNugget jump.

Billboard - Click here to change the sign.

Roller Coaster - Click here to see the Happy Meal Guys ride the roller coaster.

## GO FISH

### Objective

The object of this game is simple. If you want to win, you have to make the most pairs.

### How to play

1. To start playing, look at your hand of cards. If you have a pair (two of the same card) click on them to discard. If you don't have a pair, you need to ask another player if they have the card you are looking for. You can ask any player for a card by clicking on the card that you want and then clicking on the player you hope to get the card from. You must have one of those cards in your hand already, and the other player has to give it to you if he has what you're asking for. If you get the card you asked for from that player, discard your pair and go again. You can keep asking the other player for cards until he says "No." Your turn continues as long as you can make pairs. If he doesn't have the card you need, he will tell you to "Go Fish."



2. When you are told to “Go Fish,” a magic fishing rod will appear and fish will start jumping out of the lake! Use your mouse and click on a fish. The fish you catch will reveal your card. If it is the card you needed, you can discard your pair and go again. If not, it is the next player’s turn.

3. If another player asks you for a card, you must click on that card to give it to them. If you do not have the card, that player has to “Go Fish.”

The game is over when any player runs out of cards. The player with the most pairs wins. At this time, two Happy Meal Hamburgers will appear. Click on the one that says YES to play the game again. Click on the one that says NO to exit the game and return to the McDonaldland screen. If you are the big winner, a Congratulations Certificate appears and you can print it out and show all your friends that you are the champ.

## Strategy

Try to remember the cards other players are asking for. It means they have those cards. If they haven’t laid it down in a pair, they will have that card when you need it.

## Go Fish Screen

Pair Scoring - To see how many pairs you and your opponent have, count the number of pairs shown on their boat.

Opponent - Click on your opponent to see how many cards he or she has left.

Menu Bar - Click here for help or to return to the McDonaldland Screen.

Hotspots - These are hidden extras that are fun to click on.

Trees - Click here to pop up the Happy Meal Fries and Shake.

Hamburger - Click here to see the golden ring move up and down.

Cloud - Click on it to change its shape.

Water - Click here to see the shark fin.



## MIX 'N' MATCH

### Objective

There are no rules in Mix 'n' Match. Anything goes! Mix and match the heads, bodies, and legs of Birdie, CosMc, Grimace, and Hamburglar. When you are done, you can print out your original creation.

### How to play

1. Click on the heads, bodies and legs on the screen to create as many wacky combinations of the McDonaldland characters as you can imagine.

2. When you have finished creating your mixed-up masterpiece, you can print it out. Just, select the Happy Meal Box button in the lower right hand corner of the screen and choose the Print button from the Button bar. Now you can return to the game and mix and match again or click on the McDonaldland button to return to the Main Screen.



## PAINT YOUR CARD

### Objective

Paint your own cards, so you can play any McDonaldland game with your own unique cards!

1. Click on the easel to enter the Paint Your Card section of the program.

2. Choose the type of cards you want to paint from the three designs displayed in the top left corner of the screen.

3. In the Paint Your Cards area, you can customize your cards. You are provided



with a paint fill tool and line art of the cards. Click on a paint balloon to choose your color, and then click on the section of the card you want to paint. Click on the Ronald McDonald hand to advance to the next card. Click Ronald's left hand to go back.

Your newly colored cards will be the ones that are viewed within the game. You will also be able to print these cards on the appropriate sized label so that you can create your own deck of playing cards.

4. To print, click on the Menu Bar button and select the Print button.

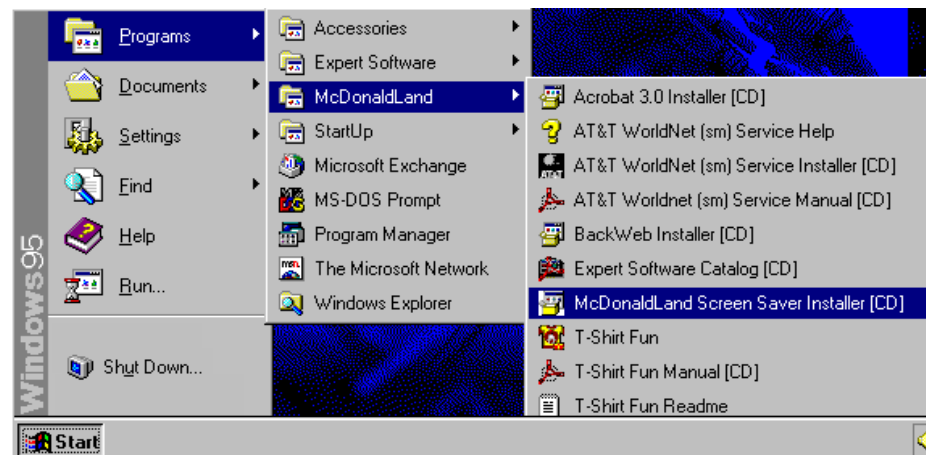
# McDONALDLAND SCREEN SAVER!

Included with this program is a free McDonaldLand Screen Saver! Kids can have a giggle watching their favorite McDonaldLand characters bouncing around the computer screen, stretching and jiggling.

To install the McDonaldLand Screen Saver, double-click on the McDonaldLand Screen Saver Installer icon included in the McDonaldLand Program Folder, which should appear on your desktop following installation. This will begin the Screen Saver install process described below in steps 4-8. You can always install the program later from the Windows 95 Taskbar.

## WINDOWS 95

### To Install the McDonaldLand Screen Saver from the Windows 95 Taskbar:



1. Make sure your McDonaldLand CD is inserted in your CD-ROM drive!
2. Click on the Start button on the Taskbar.

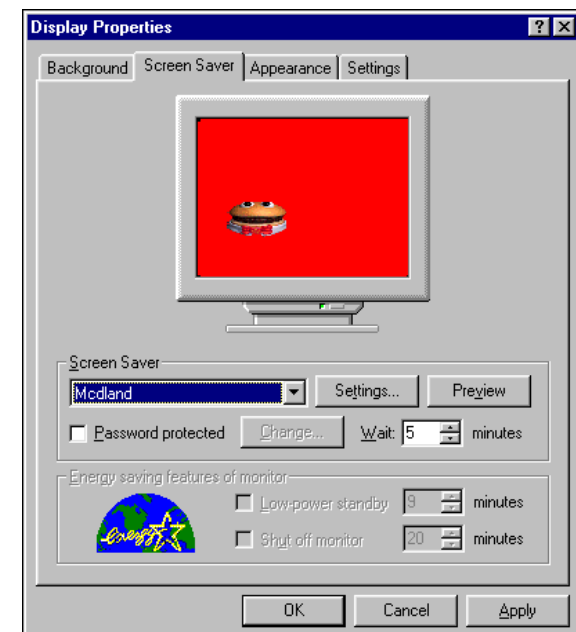


3. Choose Programs, McDonaldLand, then click on the McDonaldLand Screen Saver Installer icon. This will begin the Screen Saver installation process.
4. A dialog box will ask you to wait while the McDonaldLand Screen Saver Setup prepares the InstallShield® Wizard to guide you through the rest of the setup process.
5. Next, the McDonaldLand Screen Saver Setup screen will appear. It is recommended that you exit all Windows programs before running Setup. You can choose Cancel to quit Setup and close any programs you have running. Click on Next to continue with the Setup program.
6. The License Agreement screen will appear next. Click on Yes to agree to the terms and continue with the Setup program.
7. The Choose Destination Location screen appears next. Click on Next to install McDonaldLand Screen Saver to the default directory (or choose Browse and select another destination, then choose Next to continue).
8. The Screen Saver Setup Complete screen will appear next. Select Finish to complete the Screen Saver installation.

## Using McDonaldLand Screen Saver

You are now ready to run the McDonaldLand Screen Saver. To run the Screen Saver and adjust the display properties:

1. Click on the Start button on the Windows Taskbar.
2. Choose Settings, then Control Panel.
3. Double-click on the Display icon.
4. The Display Properties window will appear. Select the Screen Saver tab.
5. Click on the Screen Saver drop down menu and select **McDland**. You will see a mini preview in the display window.



6. You can set the amount of time that will elapse before windows displays the Screen Saver, in the **Wait for (1) minutes** section.
7. Select the Settings button to adjust the Screen Saver speed, change sound effects or turn the sound On or Off. See the section below for screen Screen Saver options.
8. Click on **Apply** to apply your settings. Click on **OK** to return to the desktop.

## Screen Saver Settings Dialog Box

This enables you to customize the McDonaldLand Screen Saver settings. You can change the following options:



### 1. Sound Effects

There are thirteen sound effects to choose from. Select the one that you want to apply to the Screen Saver and click the OK button to have that sound applied to the Screen Saver. You can also choose Random, which enables the computer to cycle through all sound effects providing variety.

### 2. Speed

You can choose the speed in which the McDonaldLand characters bounce around your monitor. There are three settings; slow, moderate and fast. Once you have selected the speed click the OK button to apply that speed to the Screen Saver.

### 3. Sound Effects On or Off

This enables you to have sounds turned On or Off. This setting will not affect any other Screen Saver settings. Once you have made your selection click on the OK button to apply your choice.

To cancel your changes, select the Cancel button and your original settings will be restored.

### 4. About Button

Provides you with information about the Screen Saver.

## Activating the McDonaldLand Screen Saver

McDonaldLand Screen Saver will automatically activate after the time set in the Wait field in the Screen Saver area of the Display Properties dialog box. You can also manually activate the Screen Saver by using the icon in the McDonaldLand program folder.

To manually activate the Screen Saver:

1. Click on the Start button on the Windows Taskbar.

2. Choose Programs, then McDonaldLand.



3. Click on the McDonaldLand Screen Saver icon. This will activate the Screen Saver Program.

Your desktop will be restored when you click on a key or move the mouse.

**Note: the Windows 95 Password Protection option has been disabled for this program therefore Windows will not ask for a password when the Screen Saver is active.**

## Uninstalling McDonaldLand Screen Saver:

To uninstall the McDonaldLand Screen Saver:

1. Click on the Start button on the Windows Taskbar.
2. Click on Settings.
3. Click on Control Panel.
4. Double-click on Add/Remove Programs.
5. The Add/Remove Programs Properties window will appear. Make sure the Install/Uninstall tab is selected.
6. Select McDonaldLand Screen Saver from the scroll down menu.
7. Click on the Add/Remove button.
8. A Confirm File Deletion dialog box will appear. Select Yes to continue.
- 9 The UninstallShield will appear and will remove the associated files from your system.

You will see the Uninstall successfully completed message when the process has been completed.
