* Fabric Requirements

¼ yards yellow for pinwheels
 ¼ yards white for pinwheels
 ¼ yards assorted coordinates for bars
 yards novelty ducks
 ¾ yard for binding
 ¼ yards for backing

Yardage is based on 40 - inch wide fabric

* <u>Cutting Instructions</u>

Blocks

From yellow for pinwheels:

- Cut 11, 3 ³/₈ x 40 inch strips
- From these strips cut 112, 3 ³/₈ - inch squares

From white for pinwheels:

- Cut 11, 3 ³/₈ x 40 inch strips
- From these strips cut 112, 3 ³/₈ - inch squares

From assorted coordinates for bars:

- Cut 24, 2 x 40 inch strips
- From these strips cut
 168, 2 x 5 ½ inch bars

Sashing and Borders

From novelty ducks:

- Cut 5, 4 ¼ x 40 inch strips for top and bottom borders
- <u>Cut remaining strips lengthwise</u>
- Cut 3, 8 ½ x 70 ½ inch strips for sashing
- Cut 2, 4 ¼ x 70 ½ inch strips for side borders

Binding

From binding print:


Cut 9, 2 ¼ x 40 - inch strips

* <u>Piecing</u>


Use 1/4 - inch seam allowance throughout

Blocks

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each white 3 ³/₈ - inch square.
- With right sides facing, layer one white and one yellow 3 ³/₈ inch square together. Stitch ¹/₄ inch away from each side of drawn line. Cut apart on marked line and press. Half square triangles should measure 3 inch square. Make 224 half square triangles.




 Sew 4 half square triangles together as shown to make pinwheel.
 Pinwheel should measure
 5 ¹/₂ - inch square.





Make 56

 Arrange and sew 3, 2 x 5 ¹/₂ - inch assorted coordinating bars to sides of pinwheel.



Make 28



* Quilt Assembly

 Arrange and sew 14 pinwheel and bar blocks together lengthwise to form a row.



Make 4 rows

• Starting with a pinwheel row alternate sashing between rows as shown in quilt diagram.

Borders

Side Borders:


 Attach one 4 ¼ x 70 ½ - inch border strip to each side of quilt.

Top and Bottom Borders:

- Piece 5, 4 ¼ x 40 inch novelty duck strips end to end.
- Measure quilt from side to side through middle and including side borders to determine length of top and bottom borders.
- From pieced length cut top and bottom borders to needed length and attach to quilt.

* Finishing

• Layer, baste, hand or machine quilt, trim, and add binding.
