### 1.4 ME\_English.guide/INHALT/INCLUDEFILE

The include file

The include file defines some useful new MUI-macros for shorter and nicer source code:

- New gadget types: ...UInteger(), ...SInteger(), ...Note(), KeyPopupButton(), ...ToggleButton()
- New label type ... CLabel... () for centered labels
- New spacing macros: HBar, VBar, HBarFixed(), VBarFixed()
- "Wt"-version for some gadget macros (additional weight-argument)

If you want to use the Intege- or Note-macros of the include file, you must insert the following lines before the first macro call.

I haven't inserted the lines in the include file because then you couldn't include it into GST files (with SAS/C compiler) for example.

The package contains 6 MUI-Image-Sets:

- Jojo\_Black\_11pt
- Jojo\_Black\_13pt
- Jojo\_3D\_11pt
- Jojo\_3D\_13pt
- Jojo\_Outline\_11pt
- Jojo\_Outline\_13pt

The image sets should be used with a 11- or 13-pixel font.

The image set 'Jojo\_Black\_11pt' beinhaltet images for arrows, all kinds of Popup objects, Checkmarks, RadioButtons, Cycle gadgets, the Assign symbol, the Network symbol and the TapePause symbol. The other images were overtaken from the XEN-Sets. So you can delete the XEN-sets completly from your harddisk if you want to have place.

The other sets contain only the images which are different to the images in 'Jojo\_Black\_11pt'.

Except of the TapePause-, Assign- and Network-images, all images look like the XEN-buttons. The TapePause-image contains simply two vertical bars instead of one (I looked at every tape- and CD-player in the house and saw that everywhere is a `||' and not a `|' on the pausebuttons).

If you want my images to look best, do the following (If you use MagicWB, the first 3 points should already be done):

- Use a screen with at least 8 colors and a width similar to the height (640 x 512 for example).
- Use the MagicWB palette (or something similar).
- Use a 11 or a 13 pixel font for Screen text.
- Start the MUI prefs program.
- Chose 'XEN Lo' or 'XEN Hi' from the 'Edit/Presets' menu.
- Change the images to the images in Jojo\_Black.., Jojo\_3D.. or Jojo\_Outline.. (page Images).
- If you don't have MagicWB change the font names from 'XHelvetica' to 'helvetica' (page Fonts).

Additionally there is a so-called MUI image construction set in the package: an ILBM picture with the iamges of all sets on it. You can use this picture file as model for your own images.

### 1.6 ME\_English.guide/INHALT/ICONS

#### The icons

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I tried to let the icons to look like like the icons in the MagicWB package. I must say that \*my\* icons don't look as good as `real' MagicWB icons, but maybe Martin Huttenloher sees my icons and draws better ones.

The package also contains a ILBM file with some new and old icon templates.

## 1.7 ME\_English.guide/INHALT/FARBPALETTEN

The color palettes
```

The color palettes shall be alternatives to the orginal MagicWB palette. Every palette exists as ILBM file (OS 3.0 or better) and as 'pre' file (OS 2.x). But you needn't to know that because the installation will install the right palettes.

The palettes 'OriginalPalette.ilbm' and 'OriginalPalette.pre' are

the original MagicWB palettes.

## 1.8 ME\_English.guide/INHALT/PATTERNS

The background patterns

In the package there are a few new background patterns in ILBM format. The patterns use the original MagicWB palette, so OS 2.0 users can use them at once with NickPrefs.

There are background patterns for the Workbench windows under OS 2.x, too. They have the format for the prefs editor 'WBPattern'.

## 1.9 ME\_English/INHALT/FONTS

Fonts

In this version are 4 new color fonts included - but only in the full version of registered users. Unregistered users can display the ILBM picture file 'MEFonts.ilbm', on which are a few chars of every font.

The color fonts are ideal for your own icon projects, because they use the original MagicWB color palette. The following fonts are in the package:

- Helvetica/23
- HelveticaPlain/23
- Times/21
- TimesPlain21

The fonts don't exist as normal color fonts but every char exists as a single IFF/ILBM brush. The reason for that is that I didn't know a program to create color fonts but a shareware program, which I found so bad that I didn't want to pay the shareware fee (In the non-full-version you wasn't able to save). If someone knows a good program, it would be nice to tell me its name or to send it to me. Otherwise I maybe write such a program myself - certainly with MUI interface :)

## 1.10 ME\_English/INHALT/MOUSEPOINTER

Mouse pointers

Another new thing in this version are the mouse pointers. I drew them for OS 2.x users (LoRes resultion, max. width 16 pixel). They use 4 or 8 colors, at least one of them is a grey which is used for antialiasing (With such a low resultion you must have anti-aliasing). There are normal mouse pointers in the package, busy pointers and busy pointer animations (The last two are for the 'BusyPointer'-prefs-ed from the NickPrefs package which is included in MagicWB). The busy pointer 'Bee.ilbm' or its animation 'BeeAnim.pre'~should only be used with one of the '...Yellow...' pointers or with the 'ArrowLeftGrey.ilbm' or 'ArrowRightGrey.ilbm' pointers, because the bee needs the color yellow.

If you want to use one of the 8 color pointers (with the suffix '8Col.ilbm'), you have to copy it directly to 'ENVARC:sys'~or 'ENV:sys', because the 'Pointer'-prefs-ed only processes 4 color pointers. Example:

Copy Prefs/Presets/ArrowLeftYellow8Col.ilbm ENVARC:sys/Pointer.ilbm

## 1.11 ME\_English/INSTALLATION

Installation

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Simply double-click the InstallMagicExpansion icon. You need the Commodore-Installer for ther installation, but if you have got MUI you have the Installer.

Now you can select what you want to install and what not. If you don't know what to do, read the help texts.

The script won't install any icons, because I didn't know which icons you want to use. So you have to update the icons 'by hand' with IconUpdate. Example:

IconUpdate TCSWD MagicExpansion/Icons/Editor2 SC:c/se

This line would update the icon of the SAS/C++ editor 'se'. The tool 'IconUpdate' was written to update MagicWB icons. So it adds the tooltype

»»»»» Icon by Martin Huttenloher «««« .

But don't get crazy because of this, the icon drawn by \*ME\*. :-)
