About the LaserWriter 8.1 patch...

This patch will make alterations to Apple's LaserWriter 8.1.1 printer driver to increase its ease of use. Changes include:

- Allowing a printer description file to be selected when no printers are currently online.
- Placing a "Layout" menu in the Print dialog box, allowing "n-up" printing to be selected without going to "Page Setup."
- Adding 6, 8, 9, and 16 Up choices to the Layout menu for maximum flexibility.

Thanks go out to a number of people who made instructions for hacking the driver with ResEdit available on the Internet. I decided to write this patch for those you aren't that familiar with resource editing.

This patch **WILL NOT** work with version 8.0 of the LaserWriter 8 printer driver. It MAY work with later versions, but no guarantees! In addition, it **MAY** work with Adobe's PSPrinter driver, which was co-developed with Apple, but again, this has **NOT** been tested. If you are able to successfully apply these patches to versions other than LW8.1.1, please send e-mail to address given under "Author."

NOTE: Remember, DO NOT apply this patch to your original file; the patch will allow you to create a new file with a different name.

This patch cannot work properly while virus detection software is running. Please make sure that you have disabled any virus detectors before applying the patch.

This patch application was made with **ResCompare**, a *free* resource comparison and patch generation utility. ResCompare can be FTP'ed from most Macintosh archive sites. Send e-mail inquiries regarding ResCompare to Michael Hecht@mac.sas.com.

KNOWN PROBLEMS:

I think I've got everything licked, finally, but you never know. Remember, only alter backup copies of your driver, so if the patch causes problems you can just go back to the original "plain vanilla" version!

VERSION HISTORY:

v1.5 -- Released 27 May 1994

After helpful hints from Jay (sorry I don't know the last name, but e-mail is puc@cosmail1.ctd.ornl.gov), I was able to track down the PrintMonitor problem. By doing a "Get Info" on the modified driver is ResEdit, Jay discovered that the "MultiFinder Compatible" flag was no longer set, thus not letting the print driver be "shared" after the PrintMonitor took it over. After running some tests and communicating with Michael Hecht, ResCompare's author, I got a bug fix for ResCompare and made a new patch. Now everything works (knock on wood)!

Generated a separate small patch to disable the page borders on n-up printing, if you so desire. A number of people had requested this feature, but I didn't want to make it mandatory.

Updated my e-mail address in the documentation.

v1.1 -- Released 05 Feb 1994

Regenerated the patch with ResCompare; more testing.

Fixed (hopefully!) the "PrintMonitor error," in which the user could not send a document to the PrintMonitor while another was printing.

Updated documentation to reflect tests made on LW8.0 driver by Joel Laird (JOEL.LAIRD %MSFC6PO@x400gw.msfc.nasa.gov).
