#### What is INI Manager?

Martinsen's Software INI Manager was developed for advanced Windows users who want the ability to modify there INI files in a safe, yet simple, manner. Below is a list of some of the major features implemented in INI Manager:

- 1. At startup, INI Manager will display a list of all of the INI files found in your Windows directory.
- 2. Prior to making any changes, the current INI file will be backed up.
- 3. Upon completion of ANY changes to the INI file, INI Manager will flush the Windows cache of the current INI file. This will force any applications that depend on the INI file to reread the file, which will in fact update all applications that use the currently selected INI file.
- 4. Complete sections or single line entries can be safely deleted using the Delete Section and Delete Key features.

#### A Review of INI Files

A Initialization file (often referred to as a INI file for the most common three character extension used by these files) is a file format used by almost all Windows applications and some DOS applications. They usually contain startup information and user preferences for a particular application. For example, when you click a check box in a preferences dialog box, a application may write down the status of that check box (either unchecked (0) or checked (non-zero) to an INI file. This allows an application to "remember" the status of the check box the next time you start the application or load this dialog box. It is with the aid of INI files that applications become "intelligent".

INI Files use the following format:

[Section] Key=Setting

A Section represents the group of keys that relate to a particular feature.

A **Key** is the object or feature to which the setting applies. (i.e. IsCheckBoxChecked=0)

A Setting is the value (either text or numeric) of a key. (i.e. LastFileOpened=C:\ME.TXT)

#### A Word of Caution

INI Manager is designed for INI files that have unique Sections and Keys. Files like SYSTEM.INI and CONFIG.SYS (DOS 6.0) do not use unique keys (i.e. multiple "device=device.drv" lines). On files of this nature, INI Manager will ONLY write the first occurrence of a section and key that match the specified section and key. Using INI Manager of files with identical keys within the same section could cause corruption of your INI file. It is therefore recommended that these entries be edited manually using either notepad or Edit Edit Section.

Note INI Manager *will not* load device= entries into the List Keys List Box.

Example of a file with identical keys within the same section:

[Section1] Key1=Setting1 Key1=Setting2 Key1=Setting3

Example of a normal INI file:

[Section1] Key1=Setting1 Key2=Setting2 Key3=Setting3

[Section2] Key1=Setting1 Key2=Setting2 Key3=Setting3

## List Keys List Box

## Key Text Box

Displays the key currently selected in the <u>List Keys List Box</u>. If this item is modified, INI Manager will add it as a new key.

Pressing **ESC** in this text box will clear its contents. This is very useful when adding a new key.

## Setting Text Box

Displays setting of the currently selected key. This is where you will change the setting of the key listed in the Key Text Box.

Pressing **ESC** in this text box will clear its contents. This is very useful when adding a new key.
