It is advisable to have a MPC 486/25SX or faster, 8mb RAM, Windows 3.1 or higher, 640x480 256 color display, and a Double Speed CD-ROM drive.

To install the Showcase CD on Windows:

- 1) Insert the Showcase CD-ROM.
- 2) Open the File Manager and choose the disk drive that contains the Showcase CD-ROM.
- 3) Choose Run from the File menu.
- 4) In the Command Line field, type SETUP.EXE after the disk drive name and click OK.
- 5) Follow the instructions on screen

Macintosh

It is advisable to have a Macintosh 68030/25MHz or faster, 8mb RAM, System 7.0 or higher, 8mb RAM, 640x480 display, and a Double Speed CD-ROM drive.

To install the Showcase CD on Macintosh:

- 1) Double-click the "Multimedia Showcase Installer" icon.
- 2) Follow the instructions on screen.
