

ProcessSwap external 1.2

ProcessSwap is an external function for use with QuicKeys 2. It does what “Location” does except it does it for the programs that are running under System 7.

Using the extensions popup menu, you select between its three modes of operation:

Switch To... : will switch to whatever application you select using the “Select Process” button.

Switch Back : will switch to whatever application was running when you last used a Switch To... key.

Switch To (From List): when the QuicKey is run, a dialog is displayed with a list of all running applications. Whichever application you select will be switched to. The same shortcuts that exist in an open file dialog exists in the application list dialog. (up and down arrows, selection by typing, return and enter keys, command-period, double clicking)

Select Process: allows you to select an application from the System 7 Application menu.

NEW...

There is now a set of radio buttons on the right side of the User Interface dialog that let you configure ProcessSwap’s ability to hide the process that you are swapping out of. These buttons let you decide whether your QuicKey will hide, not hide, or ask if you wish to hide (only available in the “Switch To (From List)” configuration). In the ask mode, you can set the ask default to be either hide, or don’t hide.

To do the asking, there is a new check box in the Switch to (from list) dialog.

To install the ProcessSwap external, use CE Software’s Extension Manager, and follow their instructions for its use.
