CleanUp can be purchased for \$15.00 (US). The following list shows the different ways to make a purchase:

1. Credit Cards using the enclosed {button Register,EF('Register.exe','1,')} program (e-mail/postal)
2. Credit Cards using the Internet (secured and unsecured)
3. US Checks/money order using the enclosed Register program

Purchasing CleanUp provides the following:

1. Removal of the "reminder screen" or "nag screen"
2. 50% discounts on all major upgrades (i.e. 1.x to 2.x)

Using CleanUp

MAIN SCREEN:



The above is a picture of the CleanUp toolbar. The toolbar uses the popup style buttons like the ones in Microsoft's Internet Explorer and Office 97. The descriptions below explain each button (left to right):

- ▶ Setup (used to setup your choices for CleanUp)
- ▶ Do Not Confirm / Confirm Actions
- ▶ Use Recycle Bin / Do Not Use Recycle Bin
- ▶ Delete selected files
- ▶ Start CleanUp Process
- ▶ The next four are viewing options (large icons, small icons, list, & detail)
- ▶ Exit CleanUp

Below the toolbar is the list area, similar to the Explorer window, that lists the files found during the CleanUp Process. Clicking the header of the list will sort the list (only available in detail view)

You may select multiple files in the same way you can in Explorer, i.e. using SHIFT or CTRL to select some files or CTRL + A to select all files. The DELETE key performs the same action as the toolbar delete button.

SETUP SCREEN:

Most toolbar buttons are the same as the main screen. The only difference is the *Start CleanUp Process* is changed to *Add File*. Clicking this button allows you to add files or file specifications to be "cleaned." You can enter:

- ▶ Location (Directory/Folder to search)
- ▶ Option to search subdirectories
- ▶ File or File Specification (File spec. can be *.tmp, *.bak, or other file types)
- ▶ File Age
- ▶ File Size

The list area will list the information that you selected for CleanUp. Please be careful with the type of files you delete. It's not wise to choose C:*.* for example. Doesn't Byte Software is not responsible for any loss of files, time, patience, etc. that may be caused due to unthought of decisions.

MENUS:

The CleanUp menus perform the same functions as the toolbar buttons. The menus,

however, have three other options:

- ▶ **Save Settings on Exit (save window locations/sizes)**
- ▶ **Run at Win95 Boot (can be useful to delete files during bootup)**
- ▶ **Register (Used to enter Name and Reg # provided by Doesn't Byte Software)**
