## **About DirectSetup**

DirectSetup is a simple API that provides the developer with a "one call" installation for the DirectX components. This is more that a convenience, as DirectX is a complex product and its installation is an involved task. The developer *should not attempt* a "manual" installation of DirectX.

# **Using DirectSetup**

Although there are actually two APIs provided by DirectSetup, only one is of use to the typical game developer. The other is directed towards those who will be installing their own DirectX device drivers, and is not addressed in this document.

Although DirectSetup allows you to install a single DirectX component, such as DirectDraw, this is not recommended as the space savings is minimal due to interdependencies between the DirectX components.

## API

There are only two functions provided by DirectSetup, and only one of them, **DirectXSetup**, is of interest to the typical game developer. The other, **DirectXDeviceSetup**, is intended for the use of manufacturers wishing to install their own DirectX device drivers and is not addressed in this document. The declarations for DirectSetup can be found in DSETUP.H.

## **DirectXSetup**

Install one or more DirectX components.

### int WINAPI DirectXSetup( HWND hwnd, LPSTR root\_path, DWORD flags)

#### **Parameters**

### hwnd

Parent HWND for the setup dialog boxes.

### root\_path

Pointer to a string containing the root path of the DirectX component files.

### flags

One or more flags to indicate which DirectX components should be installed. A full

installation is recommended. DSETUP\_DDRAW DSETUP\_DSOUND DSETUP\_DPLAY DSETUP\_DIRECTX DSETUP\_REINSTALL

Install DirectDraw Install DirectSound Install DirectPlay Install all DirectX components Install even if the existing components are the same version.

## **Return Values**

### SUCCESS

0 if the setup was successful and *no* reboot is required.

1 if the setup was successful and a reboot *is* required.

## DSETUPERR\_BADWINDOWSVERSION

The version of Windows on the user's system is not supported by DirectX.

#### DSETUPERR\_SOURCEFILENOTFOUND

One of the required source files could not be found.

## DSETUPERR\_BADSOURCESIZE

A file's size could not be verified or was incorrect.

## DSETUPERR\_BADSOURCETIME

A file's date and time could not be verified or was incorrect.

## DSETUPERR\_NOCOPY

A file's version could not be verified or was incorrect. If the DSETUP\_REINSTALL flag is specified, equal versions will be installed.

## DSETUPERR\_CANTFINDINF

A required INF file could not be found.

## DSETUPERR\_OUTOFDISKSPACE

Setup ran out of disk space during the installation.

## DSETUPERR\_CANTFINDDIR

Setup could not find the working directory.

## DSETUPERR\_INTERNAL

Internal error.
