

ReadMe for *WarCraft for Mplayer*

1) - Speech is Supported

Once the Mplayer version of Warcraft is installed, you can voice chat with your opponents during gameplay over Mplayer. Pressing the F9 key while talking into your microphone will allow you to send voice messages through your microphone and over your modem to remote players in the game.

2) - Mplayer-enabled Warcraft and its relationship to the Retail version.

This program will install a special copy of WarCraft engineered to work exclusively with Mplayer. If you have already installed the retail version of WarCraft, you should be sure to install this version into a different directory. Otherwise, your retail version of WarCraft will no longer play single-player games or games over other networks.

3) - Movement appears somewhat jerky

During the actual playing of the game, your mouse and the Orcs/Humans may appear somewhat jerky on your computer. This occurs as a result of your opponent having a slower computer than yours. Your computer has to wait for the transmission of positional information from your opponent. If his/her machine is slower than yours, there will be a slight hesitation while your computer is waiting on receipt of this transmission.
