Installation

Simply copy all files to a new directory of your choice. Read the important [Legal](#) information before use.

The application is thumbsup.exe. Launch ThumbsUp and select a folder containing JPEG files. ThumbsUp will display them in thumbnail format.

That's it!

View menu commands

The View menu offers the following command:

- Preferences You have the choice of displaying the filename of the JPEG file.
- You have the choice of showing the thumbnail image file date.
- You have the choice of showing the thumbnail image file size.
- You have the choice of sorting the images base on any of the above four displayable features listed above. The sorting can be ascending or descending.
- You have the choice of showing the thumbnail image dimensions.
- You have the choice of display pitch (size) for the thumbnail images
- You have the choice of the time interval for Slide Show mode.
- Slide Show You have the choice of causing all the images in the folder to be shown in a Slide Show mode (in their full, original size).
- Hit Escape to exit Slide Show mode.
- Hit SpaceBar to pause/un-pause the show.

The menu item above also has a toolbar button.

Edit menu commands

The Edit menu offers the following command:

Delete Thumb

You have the choice of deleting the selected thumbnail images

Move or Rename Thumb

You have the choice of changing the name and path of the selected thumbnail image.

Make Thumbs

You have the choice of causing all the images to have corresponding thumbnail files created at a size of your choosing.

You also have the choice of having a simple HTML Web page created that references your recently created thumbnails.

The thumbnails have the same name as the original file but with _tn added (extensions are unchanged). The HTML page is called Thumbs.html and will be in the directory where you installed ThumbsUp.

The menu item above also has a toolbar button.

ThumbsUp menu commands

The ThumbsUp menu offers the following commands:

Open Folder This causes scan of the chosen folder (directory) for all files with extension JPG.

Register Use this to do the one-time ThumbsUp registration. Registering disables the closing dialog box.

Use and Navigation

ThumbsUp permits quick and easy browsing of JPEG files in a thumbnail format and creation of thumbnails from original source.

Use [ThumbsUp menu](#) to scan a folder for its JPG files (or to Register or Exit).

Use the [Options menu](#) to select how visual information is presented.

Registering

ThumbsUp is distributed as Shareware. It is not free or public domain. This means you may copy and distribute it freely but should you find it useful and use it beyond an initial evaluation period of 30 days you are obliged to pay the license fee.

The single user license fee is US\$10. More is accepted if you find this software of superior value!

You can register this program by mail. Cash or checks/cheques can be accepted in any major currency, equivalent in value to US\$10 per copy. Cash is preferred. Please use the [Shareware Registration](#) form.

Registered users will be sent a registration number to disable the reminder box. This number will be good for all subsequent Shareware versions of the program that may become available.

FullDisk

FullDisk permits quick and easy profiling of the contents of a local or network drive. Menu selections permit:

- rescanning as needed
- choosing the units for display results (bytes, kilobytes or megabytes)

When launched, FullDisk searches your drive for all sub-directory trees and the file sizes therein starting with the currently selected drive. A color-coded list box shows the results and a pie-chart depicts the usage within that tree / drive.

URLegal

Think you've gotten some broken links? Well, offer up your bookmark files and URLegal, will find those bad links.

URLegal is a 32 bit application. You can choose a single file to test or recurse through sub-directories. Each HTTP URL in each file is automatically tested by attempting to connect on the Web to the target site and receive the specified HTML page.

The results of the test are displayed in a text window and can be exported to a text file or an HTML file.

A "re-run" button exists so that, with a single mouse click, you can completely re-test only the failed links (without wasting time re-testing all the good ones). This is useful as URLegal may be forced to declare some links as broken when the real problem is that the target server is very slow.

URLegal offers 21 filtering options on the results so that you can learn all the sordid details of the target URLs or simply the infamous 404 bad boys (the dreaded "Not Found" pages).

URLegal can automatically repair the pages containing the bad links identified by your chosen filtering options.

Tickle

Tickle lets you keep your Internet Service Provider (ISP) connection alive.

Tickle lets you specify a URL of a server or Web page. Then Tickle lets you specify a time period, for example 5 minutes. From then on, Tickle makes sure that distant page or server gets "tickled" at your specified rate. Thus, any time-out set by your Internet Service Provider is always satisfied - the connection never times out! Eudora users and others love Tickle.

QuickChart

QuickChart permits quick and easy viewing, printing and navigation for financial data stored in MetaStock or CompuTrac format. The user is presented with crisp, clean charts.

The color scheme of the chart may be user configured. Charts may show volume and user-defined moving averages.

Toolbar buttons, arrow keys and a right mouse popup menu enable navigation among the charts. In addition, a SlideShow mode is supported to automatically sequence through a portfolio.

MetaFix

MetaFix permits you to modify the disk files for MetaStock or CompuTrac format data including:

- editing a single quote
- adjusting a quote series for a split
- adjusting a quote series for Price or Volume multipliers
- deleting a quote
- displaying underlying facts about a quote series
- automatically scanning for potential splits

No files are ever deleted - any edited .DAT file is first saved with the extension .BAK. This is unlike comparable applications! Also, the automatic split-search is unique and provides suggested split ratios for both forward and reverse splits.
